



## TOWER BRIDGE

Capture a photo with the iconic Tower Bridge in the background. You can take your selfie from the pedestrian walkways on the bridge or from the banks of the River Thames for a wider perspective.

Take a photo with the stunning dome of St. Paul's Cathedral in the background. You can capture this iconic landmark from Millennium Bridge or from the nearby streets.

## Follow these tips!

GOLDEN HOUR
Shoot during the gold

Shoot during the golden hour, shortly after sunrise or before sunset, to capture warm, soft light that enhances the beauty of the bridge. The low angle of the sun during these times creates long shadows and adds depth to your photos.

ICONIC PERSPECTIVES

Capture classic views of Tower Bridge from vantage points such as the banks of the River Thames, especially along the South Bank or from the Tower of London. Experiment with different angles and compositions to find the most striking perspective.

REFLECTIONS

# BIG BENAND HOUSES OF PARLIANENT
