HOLLYWOOD SIGN

LOS ANGELES MURAL DISTRICT



THE HOLLYWOOD SIGN

Follow these tips!

To take a selfie with the Los Angeles sign (most likely referring to the iconic "Hollywood" sign), here are a few tips:



CHOOSE THE RIGHT LOCATION

BRONSON CANYON




ANGLES AND PERSPECTIVES

SILVER LAKE AND ECHO PARK


