THE APOSTOLIC PRAYER FORCE

The Lord Will Save, By Many Or By Few. I Samuel 14:6

Transcript: Meeting October 13, 2025 Began at 3:00PM and Ended at 4:30PM

The speaker sets the context by welcoming participants to the fourth meeting of "hot meetings" since the summer, explaining the urgency and genesis of these gatherings. It originated on February 17, 2025, with a divine message instructing to "prepare for war," emphasizing the importance of prayer, preparedness, and faith. This alert was a call to form a prayer group based on previous experiences of being forewarned about significant events like 9/11. The speaker recalls experiences of prayer protecting against disasters and asserts the need for church readiness and deeper engagement in apostolic prayer, particularly referencing areas like Michigan.

Another significant insight is on the spiritual relevance of forgiveness. The speaker shares personal anec dotes about the profound impact of unforgiveness, linking it to physical afflictions and spiritual hindrances. Citing a story of an African pastor who experienced heaven and hell, the narrative highlights that unforgiveness could impede prayers and affect salvation. Biblical references, such as Mark 11:25, emphasize the consequence of harboring unforgiveness. Stories of miraculous healings and insights into spiritual warfare illustrate the power of faith, prayer, and Jesus' teachings.

In the meeting, the significance of faith-driven prayers and the individual role as believers were underscored, encouraging believers to engage deeply in prayer practices. The narratives illustrate how believers can draw power from God's promises and how the church is called to be a beacon of light through prayer, healing, and forgiveness. Ephesians and Isaiah were highlighted for their assurance of spiritual authority and strength derived from God, alongside leveraging the power of prayer for overcoming personal and communal challenges.

Beyond spiritual teachings, the meeting also initiated prayer requests targeting specific personal, communal, and financial needs, with a strong prophetic declaration against cancers, affirming the power of collective faith over worldly challenges. The speaker ends by emphasizing that the meeting's objective is to prepare individuals for this spiritual battle and to rely more deeply on the divine rather than earthly resources. The meeting continues to stress the importance of being active in prayer, using scriptural references to guide prayers, ultimately uniting as a community in faith to achieve spiritual breakthroughs.
