

Montessori List of Activities for Toddlers 24 to 36 Months.

Cognitive Activities:

1. Sorting objects by concept.
2. Matching pictures by concept.
3. Carrying out a two-day project.
4. Associating objects and numbers
5. Matching three basic geometrical shapes.
6. Transferring equal number of objects.
7. Matching shapes to outlines
8. Sorting events by sequence.
9. Manipulating a fraction puzzle.
10. Matching pictures of parents and babies.

Motor Activities:

1. Cutting with scissors.
2. Throwing from a distance.
3. Using a hole puncher.
4. Clamping clothes pegs onto a rim.
5. Transferring water using squeezing implements.
6. Stringing objects using a cord.
7. Making building blocks.
8. Walking the line.
9. Transferring tiny objects using grasping implements.
10. Transferring using spooning implements.

Sensory Activities:

1. Matching objects by color
2. Hunting for treasure.
3. Pairing objects according to color and pattern.
4. Discriminating between sizes of shapes.
5. Painting.
6. Exploring a texture box.
7. Observing nature close up.
8. Experiencing smell bags.

9. Growing plants.
10. Working with the bird feeder.

Language Activities:

1. Identifying pictures of objects with unusual or complex names.
2. Naming parts of the human body.
3. Naming objects starting with the same phonetic sound.
4. Naming pictures starting with the same phonetic sound.
5. Looking at number booklets.
6. Creating a story from pictures.
7. Becoming familiar with letters and their sounds.
8. Listening to an audio book.
9. Using "I Spy" to practice identifying.
10. Matching letters on an Alphabet Board.

Social Activities:

1. Opening and closing doors quietly.
2. Practicing "Please" and "Thank You".
3. Pulling together.
4. Singing the "No" song and the "Yes" song.
5. Making group art.
6. Recognizing and describing emotions.
7. Planning a trip.
8. Imitating an Action Story.

Practical Life Activities:

1. Unfastening and fastening clothes.
2. Washing kitchen objects.
3. Washing Napkins.
4. Washing Windows and other large objects.
5. Taking apart and putting back together.
