Anchored by a bold double Friendship Star and accented with smaller stars, this feel-good design comes together beautifully with your favorite fabrics for a finish that's both meaningful and memorable.



MINI-MYSTERY

A fabric planning chart is provided for you on page 3 of the pattern.

Lucky Break – Fabric & Cutting	
Primary <i>shown Rose</i> 1/4 yd or Fat Qtr	 <i>From WOF (9" or 18"),</i> Cut (2) 4-7/8" squares, sub-cut once, diagonally Cut (1) 4-1/2" square Cut (16) 2-1/2" squares
Contrast <i>shown Dk Turquoise</i> 1/4 yd or Fat Qtr	 <i>From WOF (9" or 18"),</i> Cut (2) 4-7/8" squares sub-cut once, diagonally Cut (8) 2-7/8" squares, sub-cut once, diagonally
Background <i>shown Lt. Rose</i> 1/4 yd or Fat Qtr	 <i>From WOF (9" or 18"),</i> Cut (1) 5-1/4" square, sub-cut twice, diagonally Cut (2) 4-7/8" squares, sub-cut once, diagonally (8) 2-7/8" squares, sub-cut once, diagonally Cut (16) 2-1/2" squares
Coordinate <i>shown Red</i> 1/4 yd or Fat Qtr	 <i>From WOF (9" or 18"),</i> Cut (1) 5-1/4" square, sub-cut twice, diagonally Cut (24) 2-1/2" squares
Border 1/4 yd or Fat Qtr	Cut (2) 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" Cut (2) 2-1/2" x 40-1/2" if cutting from Fat Qtr, you will need (4) strips.
Binding 1/4 yd or Fat Qtr	Cut (3) 2-1/2" strips (1/4 yard cut) Cut (6) 2-1/2" x 22" strips (FQ)
Backing	1/2 yard

- Pressing instructions are indicated

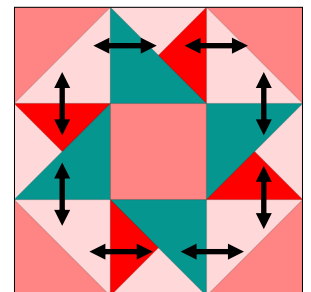
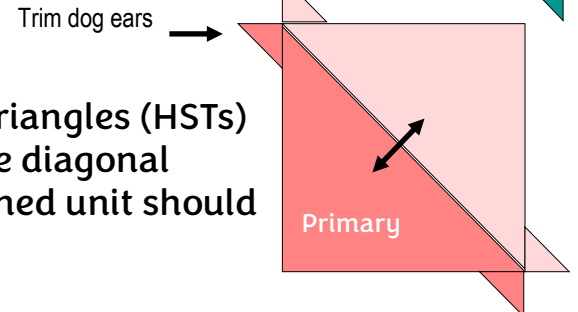
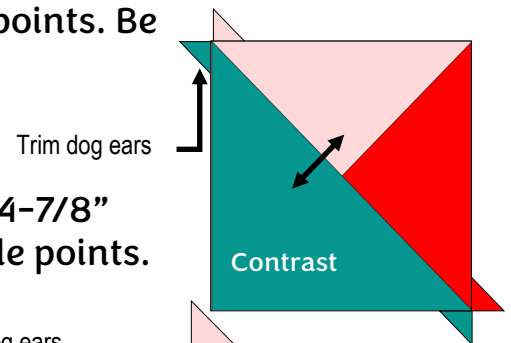
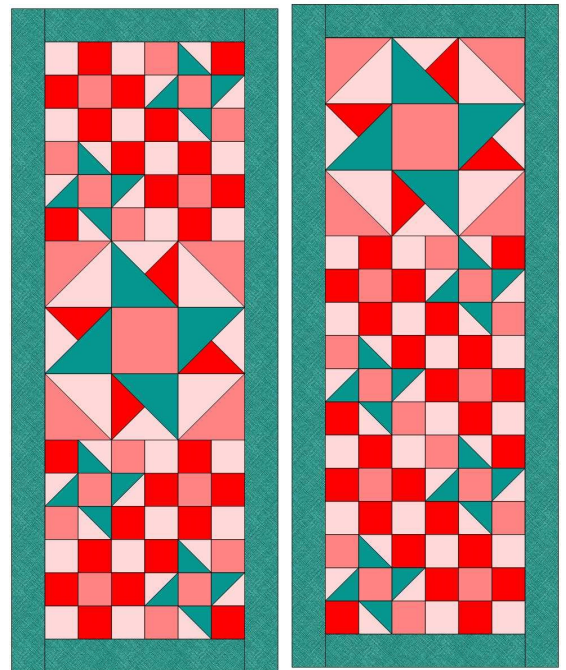
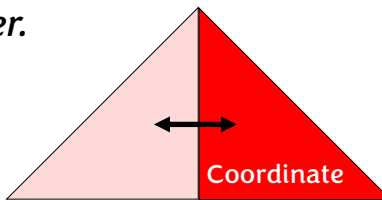

Instructions

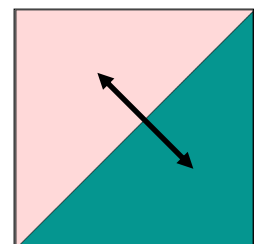
Double Friendship Star

1. Match 5-1/4" Background & Coordinate quarter-square triangles (QSTs) with right sides together matching right angles and triangle points. Be sure that the Coordinate QST is on the right side of the unit. Press seam open. Trim dog ears. Make (4) units.
2. With right sides together, stitch a unit from Step 1 and a 4-7/8" Contrast HST together matching right angles and triangle points. Press seam open. Trim dog ears. The unfinished unit should measure 4-1/2" square. Make (4) units.
3. Match 4-7/8" Primary & Background half-square triangles (HSTs) with right sides together. Stitch the seam along the diagonal edge. Press seam open. Trim dog ears. The unfinished unit should measure 4-1/2" square. Make (4) units.
4. Construct the Double Friendship Star Block using the units from Step 2, Step 3, and (1) 4-1/2" Primary square. Stitch rows together horizontally, and press seams open. Then stitch rows together, matching seams. Press seams open. The unfinished block should measure 12-1/2" square.



Small Friendship Stars

5. Match 2-7/8" Background & Contrast half-square triangles (HSTs) with right sides together. Stitch the seam along the diagonal edge. Press seam open. Trim dog ears. The unfinished unit should measure 2-1/2" square. Make (16) units.



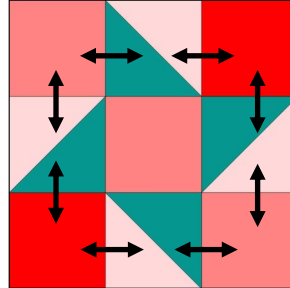

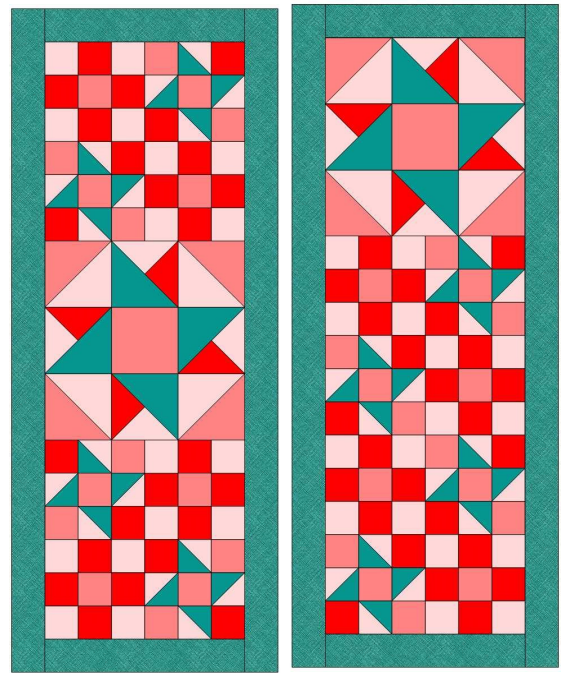

Small Friendship Stars, continued

6. Create Small Friendship Star blocks using the small half-squares from Step 5, and 2-1/2" Primary and Coordinate squares. Stitch rows together horizontally, and press seams open. Then stitch rows together, matching seams.

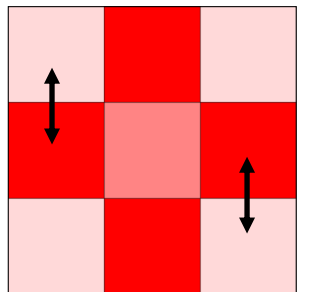
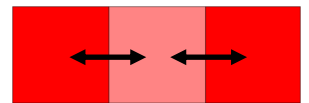
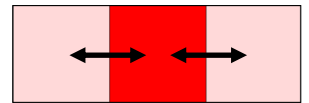


Press seams open. The unfinished block should measure 6-1/2" square. Make (4) blocks.



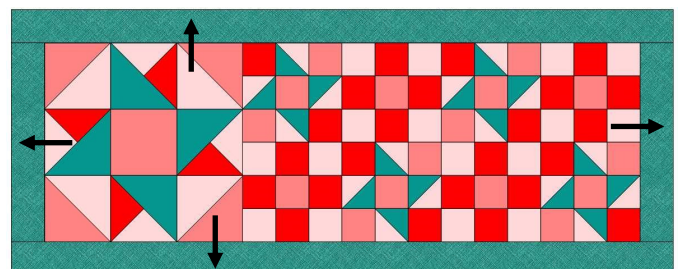
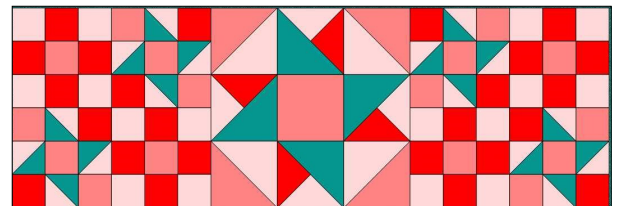
9-Patch Units

7. Stitch a 2-1/2" Background square to each side of a Coordinate square. Press seams open. The unfinished row should measure 2-1/2"x6-1/2". Make (2) rows.
8. Stitch a 2-1/2" Coordinate square to each side of a Primary square. Press seams open. The unfinished row should measure 2-1/2"x6-1/2".
9. Stitch the rows from Step 7 to the top and bottom of the row from Step 8, matching seams. Press seams open. The unfinished 9-patch unit should measure 6-1/2" square. Make (4) 9-patch units.



Finish the Quilt

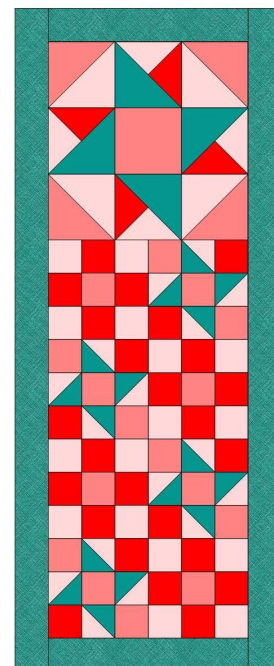
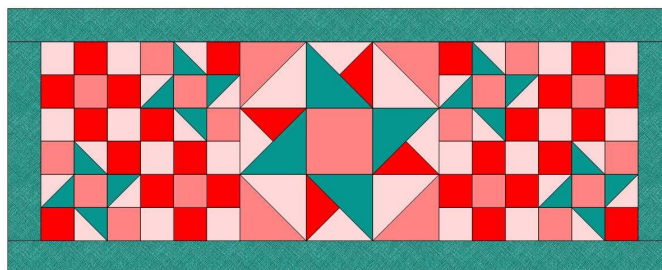
10. Identify the setting design for your runner and assemble rows (horizontally). Pay particular attention to the placement/orientation of the Coordinate (shown Red) fabrics. Press all seams open. Stitch the rows together, matching seams. The unfinished quilt top should measure 12-1/2"x36-1/2".
11. Stitch 2-1/2"x12-1/2" Border strips to the short sides. Press to the outside. Stitch 2-1/2"x40-1/2" Border strips to the long sides. Press to the outside.
12. Layer quilt top, batting, backing. Quilt as desired. Piece binding strips together. Bind the quilt.
