parade rules & regulations

The Zulu Mardi Gras Parade will start at 8:00 a.m. on Mardi Gras Day
at Jackson Ave. and South Claiborne Ave.

The Zulu Parade Officials and the New Orleans Police Department
will control all parade movement and activity.

All riders **MUST** be boarded and ready to depart at 6:00 a.m. on Mardi Gras Morning.

All riders **MUST** be fully masked upon boarding the floats
(Black Face Makeup with one White Eye. and Grass Skirt).

The following are the only riders excluded from the Black Face Makeup requirement:
Queen Zulu, Former Kings & Queens, Grand Marshall, and any female riding on a Duke Float.

Riders **MUST NOT** throw trash along the parade route.

NO COCONUTS ALLOWED ON THE TOP DECK OF ANY FLOATS!

Throwing coconuts during the Zulu Parade is absolutely **FORBIDDEN!!**
For safety purposes, Coconuts will only be distributed Hand-to-Hand.

Riders shall not toss, hand out, distribute, or promote any throws which advertise services.
nor display any commercial or political messages.

Family and Friends will not be allowed inside the loading and disbanding area **at** any time.

All riders must board the floats at the staging area.
The **ONLY** exception to this rule is the Zulu King, Zulu Queen, Palges. and Soulful Warriors.
These floats will be on South Claiborne Ave. and Martin Luther King Blvd. for boarding only.

No glass containers on any float.

No smoking of any substances on the float.

No drug usage or Intoxication on the float.

Do not remove any part of your costume until the floats return to the Superdome.

Must have enough makeup on your face at all times until the parade returns to the Superdome.

DO NOT make any indecent gestures to the crowd.

No over-loading of floats.

No money will be refunded if float malfunctions due to over-loading.

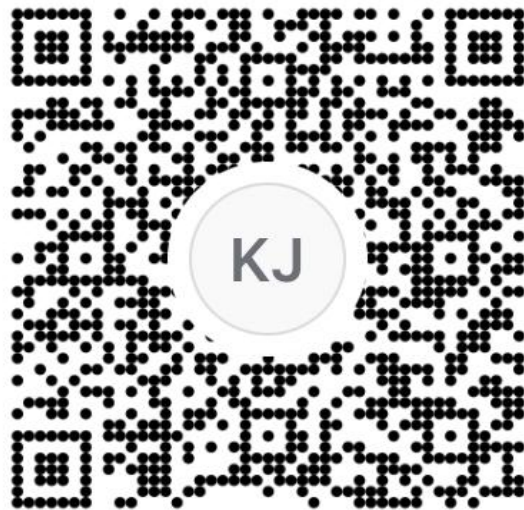
