Treasurer Report

- 1. Financial Update
 - a. Current Account Balance: \$17,904.61
 - b. Old Account Balance: \$7,079.04
 - Jennifer gave a bit of a background about EIN and creating the new bank account.
 - Old account balance is earmarked for an outdoor classroom (looking to spend \$5,000). Steve Nugent is heading up the outdoor classroom project.

Principal's Report - Brian Roberson spoke for Matt Stephens

- 1. Outdoor Classroom Update
 - a. Mr. Stephens added to the above discussion regarding the classroom. He is pleased that Steve Nugent is able to continue to help us with this project and thankful for all that he has done in the past to make the outdoor classroom happen. Continued work will be done including plants, trees, grading, etc. Long range plans include more outdoor spaces for student learning. Admin would like to provide more opportunities for students to move around and learn in different settings.
- 2. 2023 2024 PTO Donations
 - a. Mr. Roberson commented on the sweatshirts purchased for staff by PTO funds from last year.
 - b. A golf cart was the main request for the 23-24 donations. It was purchased and delivered on Sept 22. The custodial team and staff will greatly benefit from it for years to come.

Questions/Comments

Curriculum Night? Mr. Stephens will send out info for a virtual curriculum night in the next week or so. There will be a landing page to navigate to your child's class, activity, etc.

Athletic Funds? There is a general account. Some money is taken from ticket gates for all sports. Recently, the gym floors were redone and new goals put in the gymnasium. The Field house project has been ongoing. A new roof was approved by the school board. OCMS has been working on aesthetics. It's a work in progress and is being done at a manageable pace. OCMS have been given new HVAC units (2) for the field house and plan to get a 3rd one. Long term plan is to have a weight training facility/field house. Football and soccer are only sports using the field house. Bathrooms are functional and have been freshly painted.

It was noted that 6th grade sports teams are being added showing a 4% increase. Most feedback has been positive. The plan for basketball and soccer is to have an A team and a B team. The goal is to get more students involved and not discourage students.

Boosters? We have band and chorus boosters but not sports boosters at this time.

Are there student-led conferences? Some but not generally. Most are SPED and 504 plans which are part of those individual programs mandated by the state. Most conferences are set up due to concerns about grades, behavior, etc. If a parent wants a conference, they can contact the teacher, counselor or administrator to set up a meeting. Parents are encouraged to reach out with any questions they may have. Mr. Stephens shared that the expectation is that teachers address and answer all questions to the best of their ability and in a timely manner.
