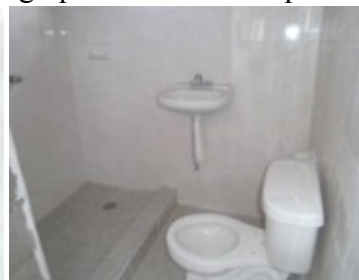
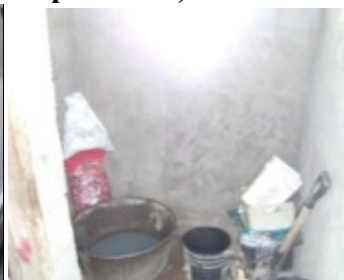
Projects for DavTee Society are under 3 categories:

Mission Trip to Chihuahua, Mexico

David, Teresa, Denise (board member & her husband), & Greg went to Chihuahua in April. There are minimal job opportunities and therefore many children live in shacks in this area.

El Comedor (the soup kitchen) is still feeding up to 125 children per day.



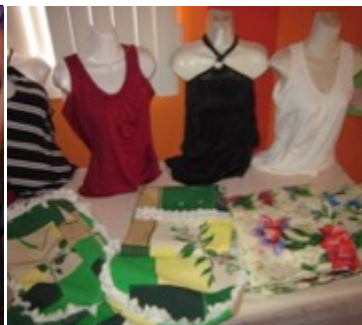
Bathroom – Before

Housing & Sanitation Project: We put in bathrooms for single mother struggling with poverty & health.

Sewing Program:

- 20 ladies had just finished intensive training & received a sewing machine for home business
 - 22 ladies were starting a training program the week after our mission trip
 - 8-12 ladies were attending a weekly Saturday drop-in session
- Fixed the 5 normal machines that were well used & needed maintenance
- Fixed 4 industrial sewing machines
- Purchased 6 more industrial sewing machines
 - Total of 10 industrial & 5 normal machines

Bread for Life (Bakery Program):

- Set up Train the Trainer sessions
- New instructors will take turns with students for employment training 5 days per week
 - Products will be used to feed the children in El Comedor
 - Excess bakery items will be sold and the funds used to feed the children

Kisumu, Kenya- Victory Children’s Home

DavTee Society is working alongside Victory Children’s Home in Kisumu Kenya to provide 144 orphans with basic needs. This orphanage has been in disrepair & chaos for a few years before it was taken over in early 2013. There have been many vital needs met with many more that are urgent now.

DavTee Society has assisted with upgrading the water system so that safe drinking water is now available. We have also helped purchase supplies for Employment Training project for welding. There are many older children in the Children’s Home that will need to be able to be self sufficient once they are required to leave the home at age 18.

David & Teresa are planning a mission trip for 2014 to Kisumu, Kenya. Goals will be to provide health teaching regarding hygiene & first aid; Employment Training projects for young men & women; upgrades to the existing facilities; as well as wherever God leads.
