### Projects for DavTee Society are under 3 categories:


1) Provision of Food & Water

## 2016 Mission Trip to Chihuahua, Mexico

David, Teresa, and Denise (Board Members) went on a mission trip to Chihuahua March 30 to April 23. El Comedor (soup kitchen) is still feeding about 125 children per day. Bread for Life program is baking for El Comedor, conferences, meetings, etc. The Sewing Program is continuing to help women in poverty.

Seventy-five children enjoyed our children's fair. We showed a cartoon movie for Easter and had games, coloring, & face-painting. DavTee Society volunteers were honored with a supper we planned & cooked for them. Being people with a servant's heart, we had to shoo them out of the kitchen!

For the adult outreach event we showed the Christian movie "War Room". The feedback was very positive and they really enjoyed the movie and popcorn.

DavTee Society assisted a single parent family living in poverty. During a home visit we noticed that the propane tank for the stove was in the house. The Mom said it could get stolen outside. We also provided much needed blankets & a bible for the daughter.

We are very pleased that Lizbeth agreed to be DavTee Society's agent in Chihuahua. She is a tireless volunteer with a passion to help those in poverty especially children.

## **Democratic Republic of Congo projects**

DavTee Society sponsored 50 children to go to the EP Cirudu school in Bukavu, DR Congo. This year we were also able to assist 18 children to begin to raise their own goats (pictured above & below). The children were required to learn how to take care of the animals.

Since this area has many small farms, taking care of animals is a great life lesson. We will let you know how they did in the newsletter next year!

The exciting news this year is that one of the students we have sponsored for 3 years has earned a certificate of merit for the highest marks in the region. The officials were amazed that a student from such a poor area did so well on his exams. The student is pictured above and he also sent a video saying Thank you, Thank you!
