- 1) Provision of Food & Water    2) Education / Life Skills    3) Housing & Sanitation

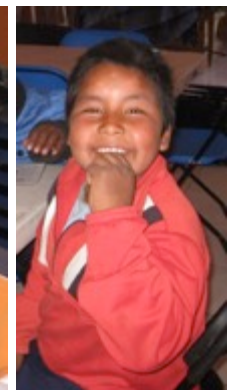
## **Chihuahua, Mexico: El Comedor (Soup Kitchen)**

We would like to share 2 success stories with you.

DavTee Society has assisted Angelita since we began work in Chihuahua. She is the lady who had brain surgery, was blind, and living in a barn with 2 young children when we met her. We have helped her to add on to her little house so her family has a nice place to live. She has blossomed throughout the time we have known her. Her daughter is now in university and her son is studying mechanical engineering!

Another family is a ½ hour walk from El Comedor. The children (six boys and one girl) have been attending El Comedor for almost ten years. The boys are happy & boisterous. The family is always laughing & joking together.

They are real entrepreneurs! The parents are not able to find regular work. They sell scrap metal they gather and make new bricks out of pieces they forage. Every time we go there we see improvements to the house and yard. Next to the house they grow fruit trees and cacti. The products are used to feed their family.

It has been amazing to see them flourish throughout the years. DavTee Society has been honored to assist this loving family.

### Programs in Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC)

In June DavTee Society opened the doors to a church for the pygmy tribe in the Kivu province. We assisted with building the church, partnering with Victory Church in Grande Prairie. The first service was attended by 370 adults and 465 children. Now 450 adults and 800 children attend weekly. Praise the Lord!



We continue to support children at the Épée Chirodu school. The Buyungulu village is about 16 km from the school. Last year we laid about 15 km of pipe. This village 1500 people now has water because of DavTee Society's assistance.



We have purchased the goats for the Kids for Kids program and are working on distributing them. Children will be taking care of the goats very soon.

### Next Year

With your support DavTee Society will be working toward a pig program with the pygmies. This program is set up in such a way as to sustain the future of the village for generations. We would be happy to discuss any of DavTee Society's programs with you.
