## LOCATING A GRAVE AT COBURG PINE RIDGE CEMETERY




You can search to see whether someone is buried in Coburg Pine Ridge Cemetery in two ways.

## **Death Certificates**


There is provision on a death certificate to state where and when the deceased was buried. In most cases, this information is completed when the death was registered.

These are two examples of the relevant sections from Victorian death certificates:



If you do not have your ancestor's death certificate it is possible to search the Victorian death register on the <u>Birth, Deaths, and Marriages Victoria</u> website. Fees may apply.

The searchable Victorian death database can be accessed via this link.



## **Search Cemetery Records**

If you are looking for the grave of someone buried at Coburg you can search the online burial database and mapping system found on the website of the Greater Metropolitan Cemeteries Trust.

Go to the GMCT website "deceased search" page and fill in as many details as you know, including names, which cemetery you are searching and any birth, death or service dates. Click on "search" and scroll down to see the results of your search.



You can then "View details" or "View interactive map" to see where the grave is and to find out who else is buried at the same plot.



While viewing this interactive map on your screen, you can click on the "print' button (top right corner) to create a simple, all-on-one-page series of maps showing you where the person's grave is. Take this map with you to the cemetery. The numbering system at Coburg is confusing and this map will help you find the grave you are interested in.
