Parent Information

Tryouts:

- Dates are in September and posted on the website (Prior Head Coaches, Royalton Board and High School Coaches will be evaluators);
- Parents are not allowed inside for tryouts;
- Players must attend 2 tryout dates, but welcome to attend all (3 total try-out sessions per grade);
- No costs for tryouts;
- All players must tryout with their own grade and any consideration to play up a grade can be shared and will be decided on by the board based on considerations taken into account;
- The Board will address the parents before or after tryout times to answer any questions;
- Coaches will not talk about other players or play time, but will answer questions pertaining to your specific player;
- Players are selected for the teams and then coaches will be asked to volunteer to coach (One Head Coach and up to 2 assistant coaches; which will all be background checked).

Season:

- Practices will start as gyms are made available (Sept/Oct);
- A Parent Meeting will be had by Head Coach;
- School sports in season take priority over the basketball season until finished;
- Practices are Mandatory 2-3 per week; Practices will be at the Royalton School or Rented Gyms in the area as needed (parents are not allowed to attend) ;
- Players must wear street shoes to tryouts/practices/games and change into playing shoes;
- There may be a Fall Season starting in Sept and the Regular Season starts in November ends in February;
- All players must play one quarter combined minutes per league rules and follow tourney rules for tournaments;
- Cost \$250-\$350 based on additional tournaments (tournaments can be Thanksgiving, Xmas, End of season in Feb);
- 8-10 kids per team (Can be A and B team) Boys – 3, 4, 5, 6; Girls – 4, 5, 6 based on league offerings;
- Most Games will be within 20 miles of North Royalton;
- If a player misses school they will need to stay home from practice, if a player missed practice unexcused they will sit a half of their next game;
- Parents Conduct is enforced to leave the coaching to the coaches during games or your child could be suspended, 24 hour rule is enforced for discussing actions after a game unless coach permits it.
