THE NAVY LEAGUE OF CANADA ONTARIO DIVISION

COMMANDING OFFICER'S REPORT NAVY LEAGUE CADET CORPS.

- The Commanding Officer's Report, NL(5)E&F, must be submitted along with the 1. Inspection Report, OD16(DSO) and the Nominal Roll NL(203)E&F, to the Division within seven (7) days following the conclusion of each inspection period. The typical inspection periods are as follows:
 - Branch President's Inspection 1st September to 31st December. Division Inspection 1st January to 15th March. 1.1
 - 1.2
 - Annual Inspection 16th April to 15th June. 1.3

It is expected that the DSO attend at least one of 1.1. and 1.2 above, and at 1.3.

- 2. All Navy League Cadet Corps within the Ontario Division will submit the Commanding Officer's report, NL(5)E&F, NL(203)E&F to DSO's only. One (1) copy is to be retained in the Corps files with one (1) copy given to the local Branch.
- 3. If a Corps does not parade regularly during the summer, but does participate in other events, these events should be reported at summer's end.

WHAT TO REPORT

- 4. In addition to the normal requirements of strength and attendance the report shall include:
 - Corps involvement within the community. 4.1
 - The number of cadets transferred to the Royal Canadian Sea Cadets, Royal 4.2 Canadian Army Cadets or Royal Canadian Air Cadets.
 - Results of all examinations. Report the number writing exams, the number of 4.3 successful examines and the breakdown of marks achieved.
 - Report the number of Cadets successfully completing the St. John 4.4 Ambulance First Aid course.
 - Report the corps activities to promote the ideals of the Navy League Cadet 4.5 movement and that of good Citizenship.
 - Report the number of cadets qualifying for their Semaphore badge. 4.6
 - Report all coming activities and the results of your participation. 4.7

- 4.8 Report all Squadron activities and the results or outcome of previously reported activities.
- 4.9 Report all DSO's visits and inspections.
- 4.10 Report every activity that the corps undertakes.
- 5. The underlying message in this sections is that, if you are going to do something, tell it in your report and once you have done it, advise the results.
- 6. Reports must be completed and on time in order to receive the best marks possible on your inspections.

BRANCH APPROVAL

7. The Commanding Officer's Reports NL(5)E&F need not be signed by the Branch, except for the reports that accompany the Annual Inspection. This change has been made to expedite the rendering of reports.
