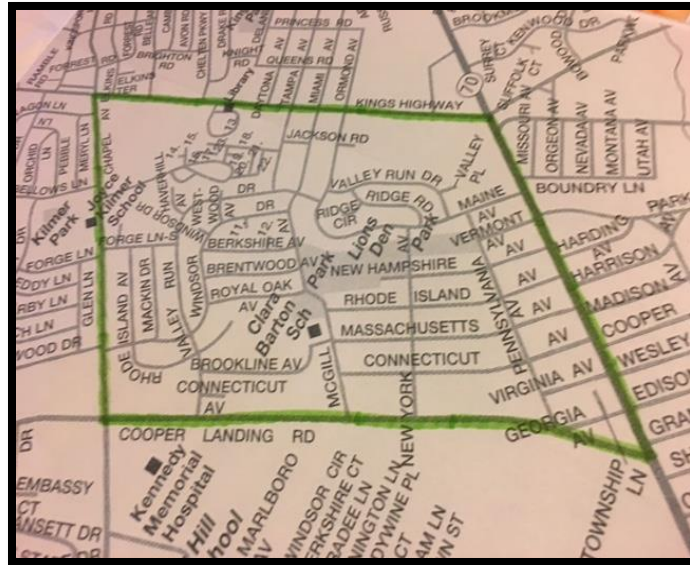


Erlton North Windsor Civic Association Update
