Scholarship Guidelines:

- Seeking all graduating seniors with a record of community volunteerism, participation in extracurricular school and/or non-school related activities, and a 3.0 GPA or higher.
- Applicants must plan to attend a two (2)-year community college or four (4)-year college or university.
- Scholarship funds will be paid in full during the month of August of the application year—**directly to the college or university**, not to the student. The scholarship funds will be issued upon receiving a certificate of enrollment for the fall semester, which will include the student ID and Financial Aid Office address. The student will be responsible for providing proof of enrollment documentation.

The scholarship applications will be reviewed by a committee selected by the promoters of the Marshall Bluegrass Festival. Scholarship recipients will be notified by phone and/or mail, and will be expected to attend the awards ceremony at the Marshall Bluegrass Festival on **July 29, 2023 at 1:30 PM**. More information on the awards ceremony will be supplied to the scholarship recipients upon selection.
