TAXPAYER ASSISTANCE - AARP is working on restarting but we are awaiting specific details as to how they will proceed. Our guess is that taxes will be done via drop off. Seniors will fill out the paperwork, leave their stuff and pick them up when they are finished. This is only speculation at this time. As soon as we have a concrete plan in motion we will be in contact with those who still need to have their taxes done. Please remember that the government has extended the federal tax deadline to July 15, 2020 and Delaware has extended Personal State Income Tax Return Filing Deadline to July 15, 2020 as well.

AARP DRIVERS SAFETY CLASS –Tuesday, September 1, 2020. 4 hr. Refresher Class. 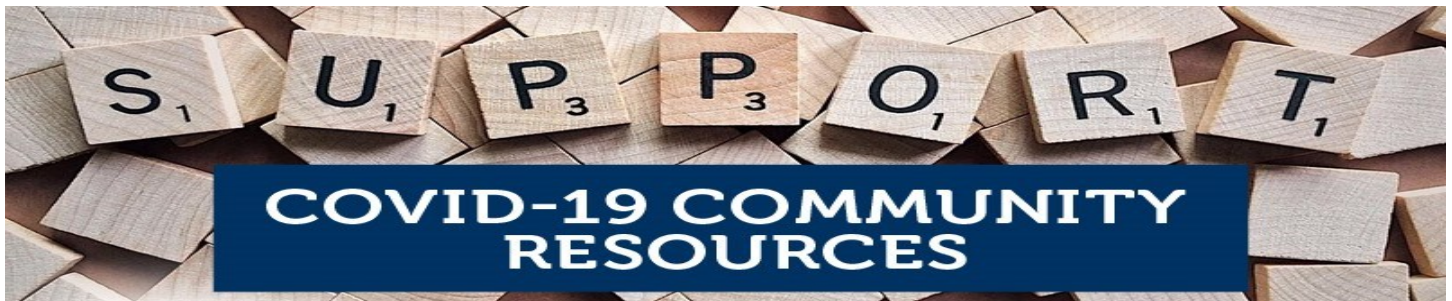
IN-HOUSE WII BOWLING BANQUET– NEW DATE - Tuesday, August 11, 2020. Breakfast Banquet!
