I want to mention some items for new members and remind renewing members. Please have your items correctly tagged when they are brought in for consignment as stated in the Consignment Art Drop Off Directions. Each item will need a tag with your three initials and a number you assign. For example, TRM01 would be how I would tag an item. MY second item's tag would be TRM02. Members should use their own tags. We do have some available for the arts center use at events. In an event that you have lost a tag from or have forgotten to tag an item, you can use the arts center's tags. Having your items properly tagged when you bring them in saves time for everyone.

Plan on participating in the Plen Air Festival on July 24, 25 & 26. Registration forms are available now on the website.

The arts center is planning on bringing back the fundraising art auction to be held on August 9. Sackets Harbor Mayor, Alex Morgia, agreed to be the auctioneer. The arts center is seeking donations of artwork to be juried for the auction. More details will be forthcoming.

July Featured Artist is Bill Christopherson. The reception for his show will be held on Saturday, July 5, 1 to 4 pm.

August Featured Artists will be sisters, Donna Strejlau and Lynn Newman. The reception for their show will be Sunday, August 3, 1 to 4 pm.

Classes are set up for registration and payment now on the website. Crochet Basket with wood base will be taught by Marcia Kall. Melissa Green will teach Inked Flowers and Inked Paintings. Penny Heath will instruct Barn Quilt Painting. Don Andrews will instruct Landscape in Watercolor. Christine Rogowski will teach Stained Glass Nightlight.
