This three-day workshop is an introduction to using soft pastels and discovering the magic that can result. Though introductory in nature, this workshop is open to all ability and experience levels. Instructor, Greg Trombly is an experienced award-winning pastel artist and teacher, who brings many years of experience to the sharing of his passion for pastel painting.

During this workshop, participants will work from photos of their favorite pet or animal. Please wear a mask and must be vaccinated. For ages 12 and up.


July 10th, 2:00 pm to 3:30 pm
