# MAID Update – Advance Requests Approved in Quebec

At our October meeting, we had a very interesting presentation from Dr. James MacLean on Medical Assistance in Dying (MAID). The focus was on issues related to patients with dementia.

The Province of Quebec, which has been a leader in pushing the boundaries of MAID, has made a major announcement that effective October 31, 2024, they will allow advance requests. An advance request for MAID is submitted by a person who has been diagnosed with a serious and incurable illness leading to incapacity (for example, Alzheimer's disease). The request must be submitted while the person is <u>still capable of consenting to care</u>, with a view to <u>receiving MAID when they become</u> <u>incapable of doing so</u> if all the criteria set out in the Act are met. This allows a person to give their

consent in advance to receive MAID, under certain conditions, at a future time when they will no longer be able to consent to receive aid.

The federal government has not given any indication they will follow Quebec's lead and advance requests are currently not available in Ontario.
