From Your Pastor . . .

July can be a very hot month. It is the month when we really feel, without any doubt, summer has arrived. Summer has indeed arrived and our summer Church busyness along with it.

By July, the donations for Peach Festival are in full swing. In and amongst the Peach donations, items are being pulled for the Holiday Extravaganza, though that is still months away.

Preparations for the Bluegrass Festival continue and those going on the Appalachia Service Project trip are anticipating long hot days of work with little relief in the evening and those veterans among us are haunted in our dreams and in our preparations of families served in the past, families who are still in their dire circumstances, living right now in utter poverty while we sit down in air conditioning with a cool drink. The families whom we will serve, are there right now as well, in a different sort of anticipation, the anticipation of their lives being made a little better with some help from these folks from the north that have such funny accents and an even more peculiar way of being, "they always seem to be in such a rush".

Still, among all of this, Vacation Bible School is being planned, and for many of the participants, their week among us might be the only time of the year that they hear the Gospel of Jesus Christ proclaimed and see it lived out, as disciples of all sorts come tighter to give them a week of mornings having fun and learning about this fellow Jesus.

The activities that we undertake, the burdens that we bear in the service of the Church, all have in common the fact that it is Christ that draws us together in, through, and for these things, and that makes a difference. A beach without the water to bind the grains of sand together is simply a desert.

Through God's Spirit, we are all called and guided through every stage of our lives. Sometimes we are called to new things and that can be scary. Sometimes we are called to do the same things again, and that can also be scary. Still other times we are called to stop and let someone else take over, and that can be a hard one for us to accept. The most important thing for us to remember is that God is guiding all of us in all things, and like those grains of sand on the beach, binding us together as his Church.

So wherever you feel called to participate in the community of our congregation this summer, remember to look around and look at the others around you as called as well; some may be long time veterans that God put you with to learn from, some might be "new blood" to offer their perspective and gifts, others might be wondering what they have gotten themselves into and need your re-assurance. No matter what, the work we do for and in the Church comes from God for our own benefit and for the benefit of the world around us, and that is a comforting thought in the midst of what can seem like chaos.


CHURCH SCHOOL TEACHERS NEEDED
