From Your Pastor . . .

Another summer has flown by, although at certain points for each of us, I'm sure it felt like it would never end! But Labor Day is right around the corner as I write this, and we have had a slight taste of the coming autumn, but now we are right back to summer heat. Ugh.

I don't know about everyone else, but I suspect this is the same universally; just when it seems like we are in store for a break, from whatever, something else comes along. Doesn't it seem as though the week before a vacation is twice as busy as a normal week as you prepare for a week off?

I don't want to sound fatalistic about things, and this doesn't happen all of the time, but it happens just enough for it to be something over which we can commiserate.

I remember reading a book by Barbara Brown-Taylor, I believe it was <u>The Preaching Life</u>, in which she spoke about how we often feel like God is feeding us with a teaspoon, oftentimes when we feel like we want a full-on feast, but it is always just enough, always just what we need, and with that nourishment, we can move forward into what God has next for us.

The good news in all of this is that God will always care for us. Sometimes God's blessings seem overwhelming and far more than what we could ever hope for. Sometimes God's blessings are that teaspoon full of nourishment for the moment.

My prayer for all of us in the midst of many transitions of all sorts, is that we learn to regard all that God provides for us as a blessing; God's blessing for us is in the feast, and in the teaspoon, and in everything in between.

Remember this Scripture from the Gospel of Matthew in the "teaspoon times":

Therefore do not worry, saying, 'What will we eat?' or 'What will we drink?' or 'What will we wear?' For it is the Gentiles who strive for all these things; and indeed your heavenly Father knows that you need all these things. But strive first for the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well."
