Easy Peasy for Peach Festival Baked Goods Table

Peach Muffins

Prep Time: 20 mins; Cook Time: 25 mins;



Additional Time: 10 min. Servings 16

Ingredients:

3 cups all-purpose flour	2 cups white sugar
1 Tablespoon ground cinnamon	1-1/4 cups vegetable oil
1 teaspoon baking soda	3 large eggs, lightly beaten
1 teaspoon salt	2 cups peeled, pitted, and chopped peaches

Step 1: Preheat oven to 400 degrees F (200 degrees C). Grease 16 muffin cups or line with paper liners.

Step 2: Combine flour, cinnamon, baking soda, and salt in large bowl. Beat together sugar, oil, and eggs in a separate bowl. Stir in flour mixture until moist. Fold in peaches. Spoon into the prepared muffin cups.

Step 3: Bake in the preheated oven until a toothpick inserted into the center of a muffin comes out clean, about 25 minutes. Cool for 10 minutes before turning out onto wire racks to cool completely.

Recipe Tip: You can also pour batter into two loaf pans and bake for 1 hour.
