My first experience with the Peach Festival was back in the eighties. I had joined the church and had gotten involved in the Christian Education program. I loved beginning children's worship in the sanctuary, going downstairs to the Sunday school rooms, then back for the regular worship service, then coffee hour in Fellowship Center. In June, the announcements started to appear in the Sunday bulletin declaring that donations would begin after the last day of Church School and the All Church picnic. Imagine the surprise that I felt when I walked in to drop off donations a few days later.... the peaceful orderliness of the church and Fellowship center had turned into utter chaos. Piles of "treasures" were stacked several feet high, a maze of pathways between them. The stage was packed with sorted goods and the smell of cardboard boxes and the mustiness of old things permeated the air. But what struck me the most was the atmosphere of camaraderie as Jean, David, Nancy, Terri, Hope and so many others were sorting, pricing, carrying boxes to and fro. I was hooked. Then Judy asked me to help with the dessert booth and making ice cream and the fellowship and friendships continued.

Fast forward to 2007... as the head of the pastor nominating committee, I had arranged to meet a prospective candidate at the church to give him a tour of the church. It was towards the end of July. I held my breath as I opened the door into the vestibule. What would the reaction be to the clutter that lurked inside? I prayed it wouldn't be one of disdain and disgust as I had experienced from another pastor. The candidate peered inside and as he gingerly made his way through the maze of stacked boxes he stopped and turned around and said to me, "This is amazing!"

Eighteen years later, I think Pastor Chris is still amazed. I know I am.
