Complementary: Isaiah 65:1-9 *and Psalm 22:19-28*; Galatians 3:23-29; Luke 8:26-39

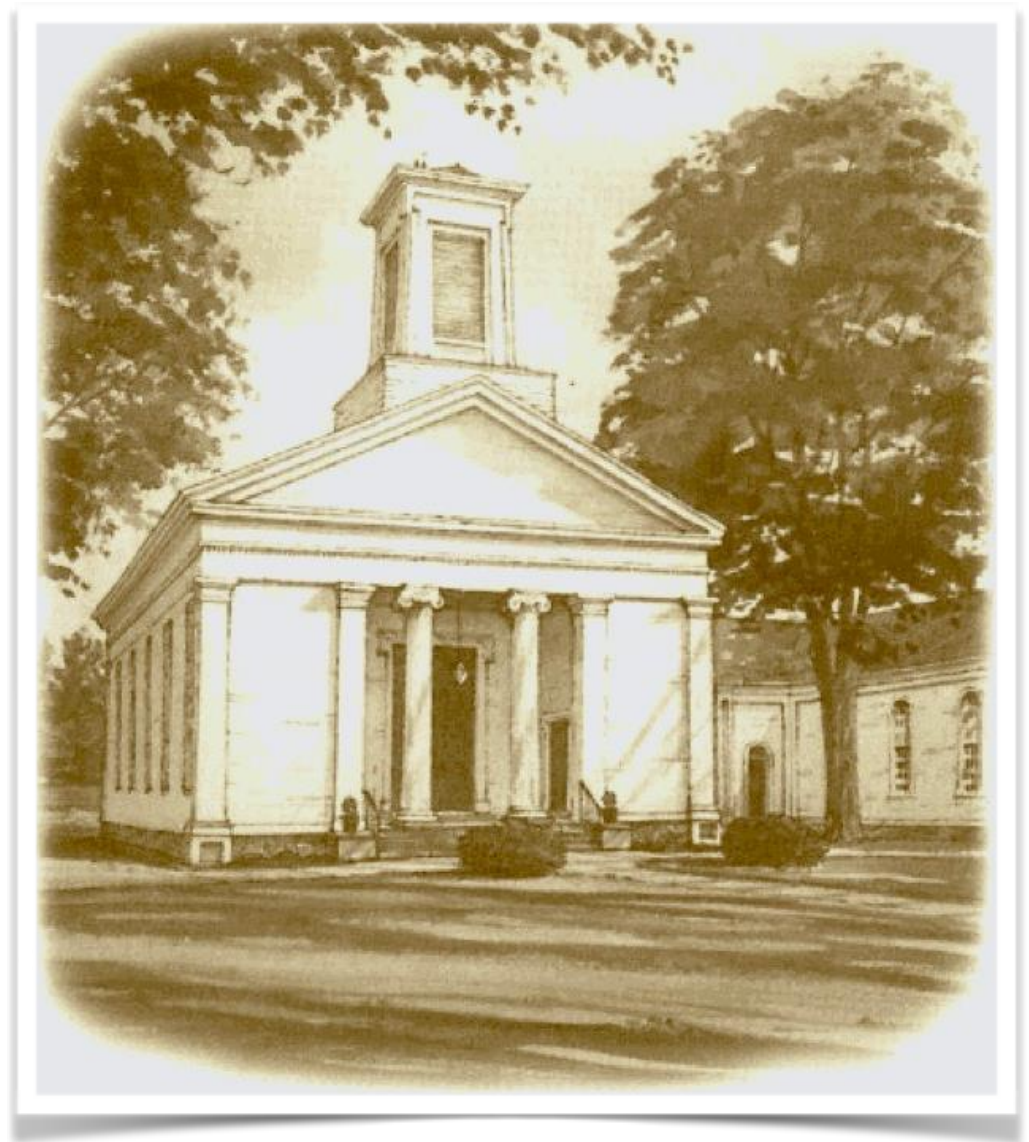
