

I reviewed 275 bills on which NYS Assemblyman Pretlow is/was the Prime-Sponsor. The list is available at <http://votepretlow.com/legislation>.

I classified the bills according to what they related to, such as "Gambling & Horseracing", "Crime & Law", "Transportation & Traffice", "Taxes", "Environemt", "Child Welfare", etc.

In addition, I estimated the extent to which each bill has "Broad Impact", "Industry/Location Specific Impact", or "Person/Entity Specific Impact".

Examples

#### Person/Entity Specific Impact

A01588 Exempts certain owners of a horse which pulls any vehicle, carriage, sled or sleigh from the provisions of torturing an animal

#### Industry/Location Specific Impact

A06089 Relates to multi-jurisdictional account wagering providers

A00322 Relates to the Westchester Medical Center's assignation to a certain peer group

#### Broad Impact

A02310 Requires passengers on school buses equipped with seat belts to wear such belts when the bus is in motion

My goal was to assess the overall impact of Mr. Pretlow's 30 years as a NYS Assemblyman. In particular, I am interested to know to what extent Mr. Pretlow's legislative record impacts issues that are most important to Mount Vernon, which is within Mr. Pretlow's Assembly District. In the process of my analysis I came across a recent bill from Mr. Pretlow that has particular relevance to me and my profession. I describe that concern below.

#### By the numbers:

275 Bills Reviewed. Gambling & Horse Racing account for 20% of the total (54 bills).

Education & Education Financing account 11% of the total (31 bills). 35% of the Education bills are specific to Yonkers. Only 1 education bill pertains specifically to Mount Vernon (the library)

Child Welfare bills account for 4% of the total.

Developmental Disabilities & Special Education needs account for 1% of the bills reviewed.

One Education bill (3269) introduced in 2021 has to do with a "regional cost index" (RCI) issue that is striking similar to the concerns that I brought to Mr. Pretlow's attention several years ago and again at the autism walk on 4/23/22 in Mount Vernon. In fact, the issue is a central theme of an Article 78 Petition I filed against the administrator of the "Rate Setting Unit" of the NYS Education Department in 2018. You can read it here:

Mr. Pretlow's bill recognizes that when it comes to calculating state education aid, it is economically irrational to include Westchester County in the "Hudson Valley" region with counties like Orange and Ulster. Instead, Westchester County should be included in the same region as Long Island and NYC. Therefore, the bill amends Ed Law so that "Tier 1 high tax aid apportionment and foundation aid" is calculated for Westchester using the NYC/LI RCI and not the Hudson Valley RCI.

Sadly, preschool special education providers in Westchester County were excluded from this bill, which means reimbursement rates for these small businesses are calculated at a rate approximately 15% lower than NYC and LI providers. What's more, several large NYC/LI preschool special education providers have offices in Westchester County and those providers are reimbursed by Westchester County at 15% more than small businesses that are native to the county. Think about it: preschool special education providers native to Westchester are reimbursed 15% less than providers who enter the county from NYC and LI. The same services to the same children, but 15% less. And here is the kicker: **Gary Pretlow knew this and excluded preschool special education providers from the bill anyway. A decision like that is hard to grasp.**
