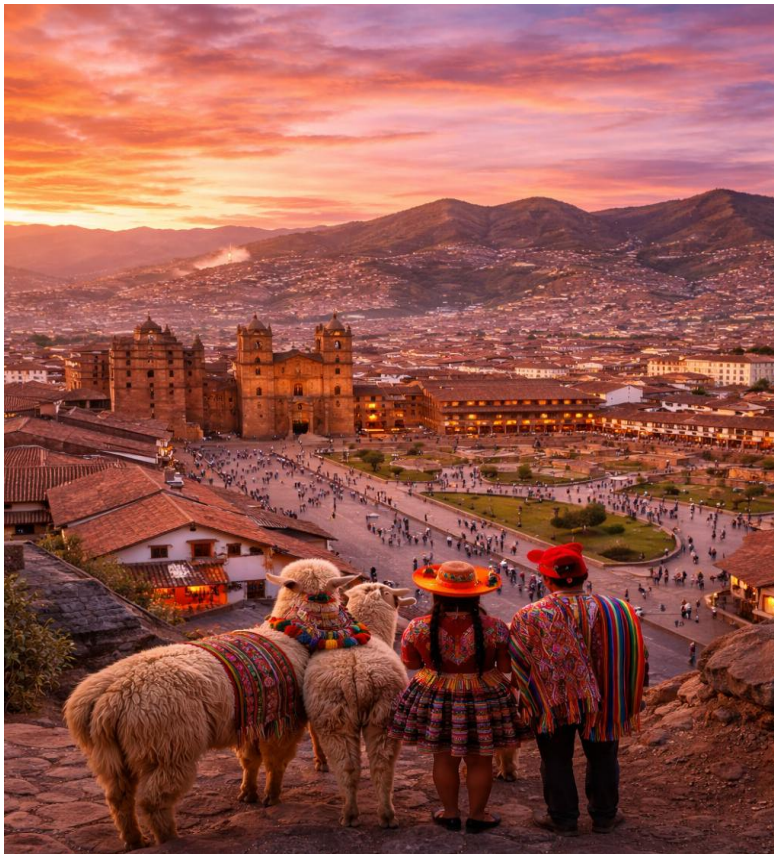




PERÚ, LIMA, MACHUPICCHU & SACRED VALLEY

DAY 1 – LIMA

Friday, September 4, 2026

Upon arrival at Jorge Chávez International Airport in Lima, transportation and a representative will meet you and transfer you to your selected hotel.

DAY 2 – LIMA – CUSCO

Saturday, September 5, 2026

Private transportation with a representative will take you from your hotel to Jorge Chávez International Airport in Lima.

Upon arrival at Alejandro Velasco Astete International Airport in Cusco, transportation and a representative will transfer you to your hotel.

Private Half-Day City Tour in Cusco

Visit Coricancha, the Cathedral, Sacsayhuamán, Qenqo, Puca Pucara, and Tambomachay. Enjoy a guided visit of the magical city of Cusco, capital of the Inca Empire. You will visit Santo Domingo Convent, built over the Coricancha Temple. Then explore the Cusco Cathedral, home to an impressive collection of colonial art, including golden altarpieces and paintings from the Cusco School. Continue to Sacsayhuamán fortress, Qenqo archaeological site, Puca Pucara, and Tambomachay (the Inca Baths), before returning to your hotel.

DAY 3 – CUSCO

Sunday, September 6, 2026

08:00 – Private Half-Day Tour to Moray & Maras

Visit the archaeological sites of Moray and Maras. At Moray, discover the circular terraces designed with different microclimates. At Maras, explore the impressive pre-Columbian salt mines still in operation today.

DAY 4 – CUSCO – MACHU PICCHU

Monday, September 7, 2026



Transfer from hotel to Ollantaytambo train station.

Vistadome Train (round trip) Only hand luggage allowed (max 8 kg / 17.6 lb).

Private Tour to Machu Picchu with Guide

Aguas Calientes offers markets, restaurants, and accommodations. Machu Picchu, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of the New Seven Wonders of the World, is an architectural masterpiece believed to have been a retreat for Inca Pachacútec.

After the visit, return by bus to Aguas Calientes and then back to Cusco.

⚠ Important notes:

- You will have 30 minutes to reach Machu Picchu Mountain entrance after your scheduled entry time.
- Reservations must be confirmed early due to limited capacity.

Lunch included at Café Inkaterra overlooking the Vilcanota River.

09:00 – Full-Day Private Tour

Chincho, Yucay Living Museum & Ollantaytambo



Visit Chinchero village, its agricultural terraces, and 17th-century church. Enjoy panoramic views of the Sacred Valley. Visit Yucay Living Museum to see traditional textile and craft-making techniques.

Enjoy a traditional lunch in the Sacred Valley.

Visit Ollantaytambo fortress, an important Inca ceremonial center.

Additional notes:

- Sunday tours include Chinchero market.
- Church visit is external only.

- Larco Museum (pre-Columbian gold, silver, and artifacts)
