DAY 1 | USA / Lima

DAY 2 | Lima

09:00 - Private half-day tour in Lima to Aliaga House, Cathedral, and Larco Museum - [Private]

Our guide picks you up from your hotel to begin your Historic Center of Lima tour. Start by visiting the Aliaga House, a colonial mansion with over 5 centuries of history, considered the oldest house in the Americas. Then, explore the Plaza Mayor, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and visit the imposing Lima Cathedral. Finally, visit the Larco Museum, housed in an 18th-century colonial mansion in the traditional district of Pueblo Libre. Here, immerse yourself in over 5,000 years of ancient Peruvian history through its remarkable collection of pre-Hispanic gold and silver artifacts, as well as a selection of erotic art pieces.

DAY 4 | Sacred Valley

09:00 - Private full-day private tour to Chinchero, Maras, and Moray from Urubamba (Sacred Valley) - [Private]

The tour starts in Chinchero, one of the key Inca towns during the Inca Empire. In Chinchero, you will visit the 17th-century church built on an ancient Inca palace and explore its agricultural terraces. Enjoy free time for

lunch. Next, explore the archaeological site of Maras, renowned for its impressive salt mining complex. Later, discover the archaeological remains of Moray, featuring mysterious concentric circular platforms. Finally, you will be transferred back to your hotel.

Enjoy a delicious three-course banquet at UNU Tiobamba restaurant in Maras.

The Cusco Tourist Ticket (BTC), included in the itinerary, is a personal and non-transferable document that provides access to 16 important attractions in Cusco and its surroundings, such as Sacsayhuaman, Qenqo, Puca Pucara, and Tambomachay. It also allows entry to various sites in the Sacred Valley Circuit, including Ollantaytambo, Pisac, Moray, and Chinchero.

DAY 5 | Sacred Valley

09:00 - Private full-day tour to the archaeological site of Pisac, its market, and Ollantaytambo from Urubamba (Sacred Valley) - [Private]

The tour will begin by visiting the archaeological sites of Pisac, home to the largest complex of agricultural terraces in the region and a masterpiece of ancient farming techniques. Next, you will explore the Pisac market, where local products such as textiles, carvings, and replicas of ancient Inca pieces can be found. Afterward, you will have free time for lunch before continuing your journey to Ollantaytambo, which preserves its Inca urban planning. Here, you will discover the Ollantaytambo Fortress, renowned as a resting place and lodging for ancient travelers. Finally, you will be transferred back to your hotel in the Sacred Valley.

Enjoy lunch at Las Manos restaurant.

DAY 6 | Sacred Valley - Machu Picchu - Cusco

Our transportation and representative pick you up from the selected hotel in Urubamba (Sacred Valley) and transfer you to Ollantaytambo station, where you receive assistance upon arrival.

Board Inca Rail's The 360° train from Ollantaytambo station to Aguas Calientes station (Machu Picchu Town) and receive assistance upon your arrival. Your return trip to Ollantaytambo station will also be on the 360 train. Each journey lasts about one and a half hours, and schedules are subject to availability.

Private tour to Machu Picchu with a guide from Sacred Valley with private guide on board the train- [Private]

Arrive in Aguas Calientes with your private guide from Cusco. Aguas Calientes, located on the slopes of **Machu Picchu**, features a lively craft market, various restaurants, and lodging options. Just a 25-minute bus ride away is Machu Picchu, an impressive architectural and engineering marvel believed to have been a sanctuary and retreat for the Inca Pachacutec. Recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of the New Seven Wonders of the World, Machu Picchu translates to "Old Mountain", which enchants visitors with its historical



grandeur and natural beauty. After the visit, travelers return by bus to Aguas Calientes to begin the journey back to Cusco.

*Remember to confirm your reservation as soon as possible to proceed with the purchase of tickets in advance due to the limited capacity of the citadel. The specific circuit to visit Machu Picchu and the schedule will be selected according to availability at the time of reservation confirmation.

(*) From the confirmed entry time to the Machu Picchu citadel, you will have half an hour to reach the entrance of Machu Picchu Mountain and start your hike.

Enjoy a delicious set lunch menu at Café Inkaterra while taking in the breathtaking view of the Vilcanota River. The restaurant is known for its unique blend of Andean cuisine and contemporary trends, resulting in a fusion-style meal with a distinctive flavor.

DAY 7 | Cusco

09:00 - Private half-day walking tour in Cusco from Sacsayhuaman to Cathedral and Coricancha - [Private]

You are picked up from your hotel by a transportation service and your guide to take you to the fortress of Sacsayhuamán, whose imposing walls offer an impressive panoramic view of Cusco. From there, start your tour by walking to the San Cristóbal viewpoint and descending towards the city's main square. The journey through Cusco's cobblestone streets, steeped in over 500 years of Incan history, blends with the modernity of popular shops and restaurants. Pass through the picturesque sloping street of Siete Borreguitos, named for its traditional use by locals transporting goods and animals, including sheep. Make a stop at the Sapantiana Aqueduct, built during the colonial era, before reaching the Cathedral, the most imposing monument in the Plaza de Armas. Finally, visit the Inca temple of Coricancha, one of the most significant sites dedicated to the worship of the sun. According to ancient chronicles, its walls were covered in gold leaf and adorned with golden representations of nature. After the tour, return to your hotel.

DAY 8 | Cusco

05:00 - Private full-day hike to Vinicunca (Rainbow Mountain) - [Private]

Vinicunca is known as the Mountain of Seven Colors and is a natural work of art at 5,200 meters above sea level. The trip starts early in the morning from the city of Cusco to Cusipata, where breakfast is served. The journey continues to the starting point of the excursion to Rainbow Mountain. Along the hike, beautiful landscapes are seen, including the Ausangate Mountain, one of the most important in Cusco. Then, there is a stop at the

mountain viewpoint to take photos and rest. The return trip begins toward the parking lot, followed by the bus ride back to Cusipata, where lunch is enjoyed. Finally, the return to the selected hotel in Cusco is made.

GENERAL RECOMMENDATIONS

We recommend comfortable and light clothing for visiting the coastal areas of Peru and warm clothes for the high Andean area. Visitors are not advised to wear sleeveless shirts, shorts, short skirts, or short clothing when visiting religious temples or official buildings. Sunscreen, sunglasses, a hat, and mosquito repellent can be very useful during your stay.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT MACHU PICCHU

ENTRANCE & GUIDE:

- The first entrance to the citadel requires the mandatory accompaniment of a guide. Please note that the guided tour lasts approximately 2 hours and 30 minutes.
- The route to visit the Machu Picchu citadel and schedules are subject to availability.
- It is important to take into account that the entrance tickets to the citadel are non-refundable from the time of purchase.

LUGGAGE:

- If passengers spend the night in the Sacred Valley, we will take care of transferring the luggage to the hotel in Cusco. On the other hand, if they stay in Cusco, the luggage will remain in the hotel storage.
- In all train services to Machu Picchu, the passenger may carry only hand luggage (backpack, bag, or briefcase) of no more than 8 kg/ 17.6 lb. on the train to/from Machu Picchu. You will find your luggage at the chosen hotel.
