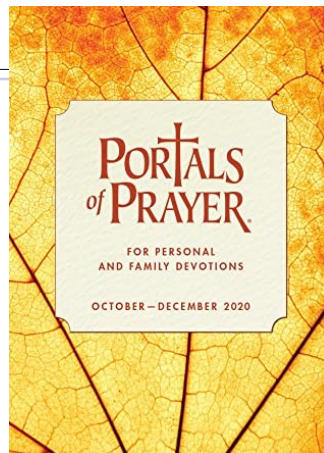

Empowering Africa's Children Orphanage

How you can help!



The daily food needs of the children grow each day as more and more kids come to the orphanage. You can sponsor a child for only \$50 a month. Food for everyone for 1 week is \$250.



The kids are learning to grow crops to help them be self sustaining. A donation of \$100 a month would help pay for electricity for the well and seeds for planting.



A more permanent building is needed to provide school and shelter for the children. A donation of \$5,000 will mean education and a future for these children.

Other needs:

- Laptop Computers (2-3 would be great)
- Seeds (quick growing beans, tomatoes, melons, cucumbers, cabbage or spinach)
- Pencils and Pens for school



\$70 a month would provide for an Elementary school teacher. For those in High School, the cost is \$150 per boarding school semester.
