

Hope to the Pacific

News from our New Zealand Missionaries

Dave had helped to set up many things on the outreach and also facilitated an evening of worship and prayer where we invited all current and former YWAM Alumni in the nation to come. It was a great turnout of approx 200 people and an evening of connecting, worshiping, and allowing the Lord to call us again to a missional lifestyle and following the call He has given us.

In July, Dave and I took on the role of training some of our your leaders at YWAM Furnace in our Leaders Internship. The goal of this is to help equip and train young leaders in sustainable ministry. It's been a great time of seeing young leaders grow.

In August, New Zealand went into Level 4 lockdown again which meant no meeting together in person as well as no school for our kids. Juggling helping to lead a ministry through a pandemic, online school for kids, and running our own training course via Zoom was pretty tricky. We did however make it through and are excited to graduate our Leaders Internship next week.

We still are navigating restrictions (facemasks, no groups of more than 50, social distancing, etc) but are continuing to adapt to missions and ministry in all circumstances. We continue to prepare and wait for the national borders to open up and to resume our work in the Pacific Islands with our medical ship and various outreach works.

On a personal note:

Liam had his cross country run in June where he was first for the year 2 boys. He was pretty stoked for that.

Elly completed her first 'Tough Guy & Gal' Challenge which is basically a mud run. We were so proud of her for sticking with it and completing it even though she wasn't feeling good that day.

Mykah just turned 3 on September 14! She is now going to preschool at ELC for full days on Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday each week. It's great for Mykah and very appreciated by Alissa!

Alissa is helping to co-lead the Leader's Internship (more below), and has been enjoying getting to connect with more of our staff at Furnace.

Dave has continued to provide pastoral care and leadership for our staff as well as taken on a new worship leading role for a local church here, for a season, serving and helping to provide new, fresh ideas and support in that whole area for them.
