Rods/Reels/Line

The most consistent and productive method of fishing this time of year is trolling in open deep water. To do this Line Counter reels on trolling rods of 7'6" to 8'6" are preferred, most commonly used in our area is 8'6" medium action.

For fishing line, we like low stretch monofilament with a diameter of .013" to match the dive curves on the Precision Trolling App and books. Remember, line diameter has a direct effect on how deep baits will dive and during this trip we will be sharing fish catching details among our group and having the same diameter line as others on the trip makes it easier to duplicate successful presentations. Our favorite line is Sunline Super Natural mono in 16lb test (.013" diameter). Other lines with the right diameter include Berkley XT 10lb, Berkley Sensation 14lb. Also be sure to have your line counters calibrated (watch how here *How to Calibrate Trolling Rods on the Teachin Fishin website*). We will have line available at the trip to purchase and an area to calibrate your reels will be set up at the hotel each morning starting Thursday.

Other common types of line are segmented leadcore(most common 27#), 30# braid, wire and copper.

Lures

Shallow diving crankbaits and worm harnesses are best this time of year. Some of the most productive lures over the years have been the following ...

Crankbaits Manufacturers:

Challenger, Bay Rat, Storm, Rapala, Berkley, Husky Jerk and Renosky in 3 1/2-5"

Harness and Blade Manufacturers:

Three D, Eyemax, Warrior, Silver Streak, in Colorado and Willow blades

Colors:

Orange, Silver/Black, Purple/Black, Purple/Pink, Wonder Bread, Watermelon, almost any color is working at this time.

Planer Boards

Planer boards make it easier to use multiple lines and keep them tangle free, inline boards are preferred. When using trolled baits with weight including leadcore it is important to set your spread properly. The most commonly used boards are Church Tackle Walleye Boards or TX-22s or Off Shore OR-12s.

Terminal Tackle/Other Accessories

Don't forget to bring your spoons, leadcore line, inline and snap weights and Torpedo and (4-3/4") dipsy divers. Adding weight in front of a bait can get it deeper with less line out, make it easier to set and retrieve and get shallow baits to deeper depths.

Inline or snap weights in 1-4 ounces will also used and don't forget good quality rain gear. Also bring you fish cleaning accessories. Fish cleaning area is available at the marina with water and electricity every day but you need to bring your own knives and bags.
