Scholarships Each year, the U.S. Junior Chamber International (JCI) Senate Foundation grants scholarships to graduating high school seniors who plan to continue their education at accredited post-secondary colleges, universities, or vocational schools. Last year the Foundation presented a total of fifty (50) \$1,000 scholarship awards. Eight of these awards were presented to students attending a vocational / trade school. In addition to these scholarships, the Oklahoma JCI Senate also presented two (2) \$500 scholarship awards.

The Scholarship program for 2022-2023 is now open. This year, the US JCI Senate Foundation will be awarding scholarship grants of \$1,500 to graduating high school seniors planning to continue their education at accredited post-secondary colleges, universities, or vocational schools. The number of grants awarded is at the discretion of the Foundation and must be used for educational expenses in the first year of full-time study. Scholarship Applications were distributed to high school counselors in the State of Oklahoma the first week of October but if you know of a senior planning to continue their education after graduation, please direct them to our website for application information. 
