# IV, January 2025 Principal's Report Mrs. Lisa Shanks, Principal

I. <u>Synchronous Learning Days</u>— Work for day 2 needs to be turned in by this Wednesday to be counted present.

Devices don't come home every day in K-5 like they do in sixth grade. They don't go home over the weekend because of the fact that they don't get Charged and students need them fully charged to be able to use them on Mondays.

- Interim Assessments—We completed our NWEA interim assessments with K-2 before winter break.
   K-2 parents should have received the NWEA reports with student's report cards.
   Gr. 3-6 begin their interim assessments with the ILearn Checkpoints beginning tomorrow and running through the end of the week.
- III. Random Acts of Kindness— Adopting another school in our North
  Attendance District who can benefit from random acts of kindness from our Mustangs.
- IV. Our 3rd graders did an amazing job at their wax museum last Friday. Thanks to to the teachers and students for their hard work and Jen DeLutri for her Sweet decorations.
- V. Thank you to Mr. Darrel, Klnzy Amos, Lisa Hill, and Julie Burczyk for their help on getting the kindness clings up throughout all of our restrooms so when students returned after Martin Luther King, Jr. Day, they had quotes of kindness ready to greet them!
- VI. We have had 17 new students enroll since our return from winter break. We also have a new third grade teacher here at McCutchanville. Mr. Bernhardt took
  Mrs. McCutchan's position and Mrs. Kait Singleton is the third grade assistant.
  Mrs. Singleton has been with us working as a first grade assistant for several years.
- VII. A friendly reminder that after parties or class programs, students participating in the event can be checked out for the rest of the afternoon. However, siblings cannot due to the lack of capacity to check out everyone. This is our busiest time of the day and safety is our number one at McCutchanville. If parents want to pick up a sibling, we ask them to let the sibling's teacher know that the dismissal will be parent pick up. Then the parent needs to get in line immediately so that they can pick up siblings.
- VIII. <u>Friday Family Lunch Visitors</u>— Visitation for families to come in for lunch with their child is on the first and last Friday of each month. This Friday is a first one for this semester. We have sent out the other dates so families can mark their calendars. The same protocols are still in place. Please plan ahead so that you make it on time especially if you are stopping somewhere to pick up a special lunch for your child. This is something that you can do for your child, but not share with other children due to allergies. This is something that we just did not have the capacity to do every Friday so we tried to create a win with the first and last Friday of each month.

- IX. <u>Mascot</u>— Boomer will be making his first appearance in the near future. We look forward to having him join the Mustang Family.
- X. <u>Lost and Found</u>— Our Lost and Found continues to grow. PTSA has bagged up all of the coats and sweatshirts to donate to Hangers. *Please take time to put your child's name in your kids' jackets and sweatshirts*.
