



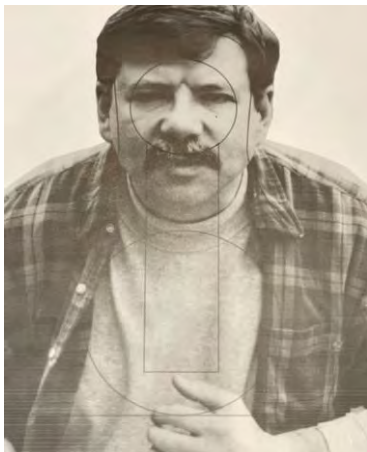
Police Sniper Qualification

INSTRUCTIONS: 20 round course of fire. Standard should be shot cold. Snipers may select a single shooting bag to use for and may not switch bags. Bag must be carried for entire course of fire regardless. Sniper must carry a pack weighing at minimum 10 lbs between yard lines during qualification (it does not have to be worn when shooting). Any movement done with loaded rifle must be done on cover safe (bolt action) or with safety on (semi-auto). Muzzle must be controlled at all times. Sniper's are responsible for maintaining a working rifle at all times and fixing malfunctions as they occur - no alibis shall be given for sniper equipment malfunctions.

1*	100	HOSTAGE TAKER TARGET (1)	Rapid Deployment hostage taker shot - Begin with rifle in case drag bag or pack, loaded magazine, bolt closed on an empty chamber. Shooters have 1 minute to run 100 yards, deploy and load rifle, and fire 1 round to hostage taker cranial vault from a prone position. PASS / FAIL SHOT	60 SECONDS	1	1
2	100	WI DOJ HEAD (2)	Rifle case or drag bag used on stage 1 may be discarded. Standing with all gear in hand. Go to prone off pack and fire 2 rounds in 30 seconds to DOJ target cranial vault. No support bags or any part of the rifle may touch the ground.	30 SECONDS	2	3
3	75	WI DOJ B ZONE (4)	Tripod or barricade and chair setup at 75 yards. All rounds fired will be to the DOJ B zone. Begin at 100 yard line, all gear in hand. Run to 75 yards and fire 2 rounds standing from tripod/barricade. Move rifle to chair and fire two rounds supported from seat of chair, move to prone and fire 2 rounds.	60 SECONDS	6	9
4	75	WI DOJ B ZONE (2)	Standing with all gear in hand at 75 yardline. On signal go prone and fire 2 rounds support shoulder and support firing hand to DOJ target B zone.	30 SECONDS	2	11
5	50	WI DOJ HEAD (1)	Begin standing with all gear in hand. On signal run to 50, go prone and fire 1 round to DOJ target cranial vault	30 SECONDS	1	15
6	25	WI DOJ B ZONE (3)	Begin standing all gear in hand at 50 yardline. On signal run to 25, fire 1 round standing, 1 round keeling, 1 round sitting to DOJ target B zone.	60 SECONDS	3	14
7	150	WI DOJ B ZONE (1). DOJ HEAD (1)	Begin at 150 with all gear in hand, and only one round loaded in gun. On signal, go prone and fire 1 round to body, reload or hand feed, and fire a 1 additional round to DOJ target cranial vault.	30 SECONDS	2	17
8	200	WI DOJ B ZONE (2)	Standing at 200 yardline with all gear in hand. On signal, go prone and fire 2 rounds to DOJ target B zone.	30 SECONDS	2	19
9*	100	HOSTAGE TAKER TARGET (1)	Begin with all gear in hand standing at 200 yardline. On signal, run to 100, go prone and fire 1 round to hostage taker cranial vault. PASS / FAIL SHOT.	60 SECONDS	1	20

SCORING: 20 points possible (2 rounds hostage taker cranial vault, 4 rounds WI DOJ head, 14 rounds WI DOJ B zone. Hostage taker target (stage 1 & 9) is pass/fail - any misses on these stages results in an automatic failure. "Line breaks" count as a hit on that target, including hostage target. Rounds fired over the time limit shall be counted as -1 off the final score. **Basic Standard is 80% (14 total on the DOJ target plus the two mandatory hostage taker shots) must be present in the correct scoring areas to pass (80%). Advanced / Instructor Class Standard is 90% (16 rounds in DOJ target + 2 hostage taker rounds).**

Target & Scoring Information



Two targets are used for the qualification. The standard WI-DOJ Training & Standards Bureau Qualification Target and the hostage taker target which shows approximately 3/4 of the hostage takers face behind a hostage. The DOJ cranial vault is designated by a 4.5" circle in the target head (the bottom circle is completed). The DOJ "B zone" consists of an 8" circle in the upper chest area of the target.

The cranial vault of the hostage taker target is approximately 4" circumference with the left 25% obscured by the hostage.

Any rounds which are deemed to break a line count as a hit. This includes if a round breaks the vertical line separating the face of the hostage from the hostage taker. For Basic Sniper Certification a .308 overlay shall be used as needed to confirm hit / miss. All instructor calls are final.

If 200 yard range is not available, stages 7-8 may be shot on a 100 yard range on the reduced target sheet.
