

LE Red Dot Pistol Instructor is a 16-hour course designed to teach LE firearms instructors how to instruct LEOs on the use of the pistol mounted optic, and develop a PMO program/policy at their agency. Course at minimum covers:

- **Classroom (4 hours)**
 - Optic & equipment overview
 - Mounting & maintenance
 - Transition training development
 - Program & policy development
 - Use of force & training case law review
 - Remediating shooter errors
 - Reality-based training development
 - Principles of threat focused shooting & optic use
- **Live-fire Range (12 hours)**
 - Marksmanship
 - Zeroing
 - Presentation / draw
 - Target-focused shooting
 - Target transitions & moving targets
 - Multiple shots
 - Close quarter shooting
 - Target discrimination
 - Balancing speed & accuracy
 - Understanding limitations
 - Dot failure / remedial action / obscured lens / back up iron sight use
 - Diagnosing & correcting shooter errors
