

Kristin Chucci is a mixed media artist combining resin, canvas and recycled materials to create a thought provoking experience.
Inspired by her adventures as Ms Earth and volunteering, Kristin is dedicated to producing zero waste art.

"Zero waste art means whatever waste I create is either traditionally recycled or becomes part of my next art piece. Did I coin the term... possibly. My hope is it inspires artists to reflect on how their art impacts not only people but our planet."

Finding beauty in everything allows Kristin to create each unique piece of art by using repurposed materials. At times, what some would call "trash" becomes the very inspiration of the work of art.

Discovering beautiful nuggets of recycled materials amongst the often tortured canvas is much like Kristin's life Journey. Diagnosed with depression at 16, she spent most of her life struggling to live until putting paint to canvas. The almost tortured appearance mixed with beauty is an unconscious choice and representation of her mantra "No matter how much darkness is around you, beauty also exists if you just take a moment to see it.









During her lifelong journey as a fine artist, Stephanie Leyden continues to master bold colors, dramatic lighting, and both striking yet playful themes in her acrylic paintings. After graduating with a Bachelor's degree of Fine Art from the University of Saint Francis in Fort Wayne, IN in 2009, her artistic journey brought her to South Florida, where she still resides today. With a challenging start in framed art sales, her career eventually blossomed into becoming the proud owner of Art Attack since 2013, a local gallery in downtown Fort Lauderdale. As Art Attack grew, so did the neighborhood. After years of providing artistic services, events, and eventually artwalks at Art Attack, the neighborhood alliance MASS District was born, co-founded and aptly named (Music & Arts South of Sunrise) by Stephanie. During the many years since Art Attack's conception, Stephanie has

continued her artistic adventure with various art events, in-house gallery services, workshops/classes, and the creation and hosting of our very own Art Brawl at Art Attack, a live art competition for artists to showcase their unique talents. Many of these accomplishments can be found in local publications such as: Lifestyle Magazine, Living in Oakland Park, Fort Lauderdale Illustrated, the Sun Sentinel, and more.



Second to her love of creating is teaching. She teaches one-on-one resin and alcohol ink courses and workshops in person or online.













Artist Karim About "New Day" Painting, Resin on Canvas, Framed Size: 24'' W x 24'' H x 1 D in 2022 USA \$2,000



THE NATIONAL MIAMIBEACH PAUL MCDERMOTT

Paul depicts the art of the human experience through observation and interaction with the world. He explores the planet to capture simple yet profound moments that leave viewers as if they were there themselves. Transporting the viewer to a specific moment in time provides an opportunity for awareness and presence.

Paul has been a photographer since the age of 14. His teen years began in photo labs and continued with a pursuit of technical photography skills in college. He has received numerous acknowledgements for his work including two Imaging Excellence Awards in 2022, 2022 Silver Award for WPE Photographers International Competition, the 2021 Spectrum Spotlight Award during Miami Art Week, 2020 Silver Award for WPE Photographers International Competition, two National Exhibit Merit Awards from Professional Photographers of America in 2018, two in 2017, two in 2015, and three in 2014. He was published internationally in the 2014 Loan Collection Book and earned Two Loan Collection Awards in that competition. Other awards include the 2008 Ocean City Arts Center "Best in Show" award and the 2005 Scholastic Art Awards "Portfolio Gold Key Award." Paul's greatest personal artistic honor was replacing Peter Lik's photography on Lik's own yacht, Stealth, after the new owners discovered Paul's work and, in 2021, he also became a contributor featured by Hasselblad. In 2022 Paul has additionally been featured by Aquatech.

Paul's "pandemic pivot" from a successful commercial photography career led to opening the Paul is Everywhere Gallery in early 2021. Throughout 2020, while participating in numerous exhibitions, he made the transition to fine art full time and became a resident artist at ArtServe in Ft Lauderdale. In 2021 the gallery launched within the ArtServe Building. Since opening Paul has participated in domestic and international exhibitions.



Photograph collection showcased depict: daytime, nightfall, and the uncontrollable power of lightning. More photos can be requested from this series.










