O Jesus, whose Adorable Face will fill the just with joy for all eternity, **have mercy on us.**



## Devotion to the Holy Face of Jesus



**“Look to the Lord and His strength; seek His face always.”**

*1 Chronicles  
16:11*

From 1842-1846, Jesus spoke to a French Carmelite nun - Sister Marie of St. Peter of Tours, France - asking her to spread devotion to His Suffering Face to appease God's wrath from the sins of blasphemy, communism, atheism, and the profanation of Sundays and Holy Days.

Jesus told Sister Marie this devotion would be needed most in our modern times if humanity did not repent, and also that Satan would do all in his power to stop it.

As predicted, we have not heeded the message of repentance in the 20th century. Jesus and Mary continue to appear to children and humble religious (from the children at Fatima to Sister Faustina of Divine Mercy and Sister Sasagawa of Our Lady of Akita). They urgently call us to prayer and repentance, to save souls and for world peace and conversion.

When we look upon the Face of God's Holy Son, we atone for sins and those of the world. Not only do we appease His anger, but we boldly battle the powers of darkness and grow in holiness.
