1. Acknowledgment of Risk

2. Assumption of Risk

The Participant voluntarily and willingly assumes full responsibility for any risks of loss, property damage, or personal injury, including death, that may be sustained as a result of using the Park. The Participant acknowledges that they are using the Park at their own risk.

3. Release and Waiver

In consideration of being allowed to use the Park, the Participant hereby releases, waives, and discharges the City, its officers, employees, agents, and volunteers from any and all liability, claims, demands, actions, and causes of action whatsoever arising out of or related to any loss, damage, or injury, including death, that may be sustained by the Participant, whether caused by the negligence of the City or otherwise, while using the Park.

4. Indemnification

The Participant agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the City from and against any and all claims, actions, damages, costs, and expenses, including attorney's fees, arising out of or resulting from the Participant's use of the Park, including any claims arising from the negligence of the City.

5. Medical Treatment

The Participant hereby authorizes the City to obtain emergency medical treatment for the Participant in the event of injury or illness while using the Park. The Participant agrees to be responsible for any medical expenses incurred as a result of such treatment.

6. Governing Law

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Idaho.

7. Severability
