ORDINANCE NO. 34

AN ORDINANCE declaring intention to sell Lots One (1) and Two (2) in Block Twenty-Five (25) of Dietrich, Idaho, as shown by the plat thereof filed June 5, 1909, and on file in the office of the Lincoln County Recorder at Shoshone, Idaho;

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Dietrich, Idaho:

That the City of Dietrich, by and through its Mayor and City Counsel, hereby declares that Lots One (1) and Two (2) of Block Twenty-Five (25) of Dietrich, Idaho, as shown by the plat thereof filed June 5, 1909, and on file in the office of the Lincoln County Recorder at Shoshone, Idaho, are not used for public purposes or have ceased to be used for such purposes and hereby declares its intention to sell the same under the terms and conditions as follows:

The City Council of Dietrich, Idaho, with confirmation by the Mayor, shall appoint three disinterested persons to appraise said property and file with the clerk, a minimum price at which the same may be sold and the sale thereof shall be made at public auction to the highest and best bidder for cash in an amount not less than the minimum price filed by said appraisers, provided however, that the City reserves the right to reject any and all bids.

Said sale shall be made at the City Office on the <u>10</u> day of <u>Mar.</u>, 1974, which date is at least 60 days after the date of the passage of this Ordinance.
