

RESOLUTION NO. 96-1

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF DIETRICH, IDAHO
AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN THE GEM COMMUNITY PROGRAM OF THE
IDAHO DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of Dietrich, Idaho is concerned about the economic health of the community and its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to support the efforts within and by this community to become more prepared to support and foster the appropriate economic activities of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Idaho Department of Commerce has developed the GEM Community Program that is specifically designed to help communities help themselves prepare for and sustain an effective economic development program.

NOW, THEREFOR BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of Dietrich, Idaho hereby supports and endorses participation of the City of Dietrich in the GEM Community Program of the Idaho Department of Commerce; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the elected leadership of Dietrich realizes successful implementation of the GEM Community Program requires dedicated effort; and that this Resolution is a pledge of our honest intention to complete the requirements for GEM Community certification; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Dietrich Action Team is the organization authorized to perform the tasks necessary for certification as a GEM Community, and the implementation of any related programs and sustaining the ongoing local community and economic development effort, and that said organization will follow the guidelines established by the Idaho Department of Commerce in performing the tasks necessary for certification as a GEM Community, and that said organization shall report to the City Council not less than quarterly regarding its progress.

This Resolution is in full effect upon its adoption.
