

**RESOLUTION NUMBER 99-1**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DIETRICH, IDAHO REVISING AND SETTING FEES FOR THE HOOK-UP OF WATER, AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE FOR THE ENACTMENT OF THE FEES SO SET,**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Dietrich has, by ordinance enacted, established that Water Hook-up fees will be set from time to time as needed by Resolution of the City Council; and

**WHEREAS**, the costs involved in providing water meters and hook-ups have increased; and


**WHEREAS**, the cost of such are to be paid for by the owner of the property or the user of the water; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has determined that hook-up, meter purchase, maintenance, and initial ground work cost approximately \$1500 per hook-up if a street crossing is not required and approximately \$1750 if a street is to be crossed. Hook-ups that involve rock excavation or additional work will be charged additional fees to reflect the increased cost to the City.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

- 1. The fees for water hook-ups are \$1500 per hook-up if no street crossing is required and \$1750 if a street crossing is required. If any rock excavation or additional work is required, the costs will be added onto the cost of the hook-up fee.**
- 2. The effective date for implementation of revised hook-up fees is July 6, 1999.**
