Nevada Ready! State Pre-K Classrooms Now in Private Child Care Centers!

What is Nevada Ready! Pre-K?

Nevada Ready! is an assistance program that provides access to high quality Pre-K experiences through a state grant from the Nevada Department of Education in partnership with United Way of Northern Nevada and the Sierra.

Who is eligible to participate?

Children must be four years old by September 30th, and families must meet income qualifications. For more information, please contact any participating center.

How does my child benefit?

Children engage in high quality learning with trained teaching staff. Staff provide intentional and age-appropriate experiences which are informed by State Pre-K standards. Meaningful, hands-on learning created the foundation for kindergarten readiness.

What's included in high-quality Pre-K?

- A minimum experience of 25 hours per week.
- Evidence-based curriculum and assessment to prepare children for kindergarten.
- Exploration with thematic learning materials in a playbased environment.

How do I enroll in Nevada Ready! Pre-K?
