



CO 141 bridge rehabilitation and improvements to begin May 23

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Colorado Department of Transportation will begin the bridge rehabilitation project in coordination with the RAMP Bridge Preventative Maintenance Program. KSK, LLC has been selected for this project.

The project will include restoring bridge deck integrity, waterproofing, resurfacing, and pavement markings along this stretch of CO 141.

PROJECT SCHEDULE & LOCATION

Construction will begin the week of May 23 and will continue into late September, with work taking place at three locations primarily between Naturita and Gateway. Crews will work at individual MP 59.075, 74.127, and 88.421, along CO 141.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

Travelers will encounter construction operations Monday through Friday, from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Vehicles will be reduced to single-lane, alternating traffic intermittently in either direction, throughout the duration of the project.
