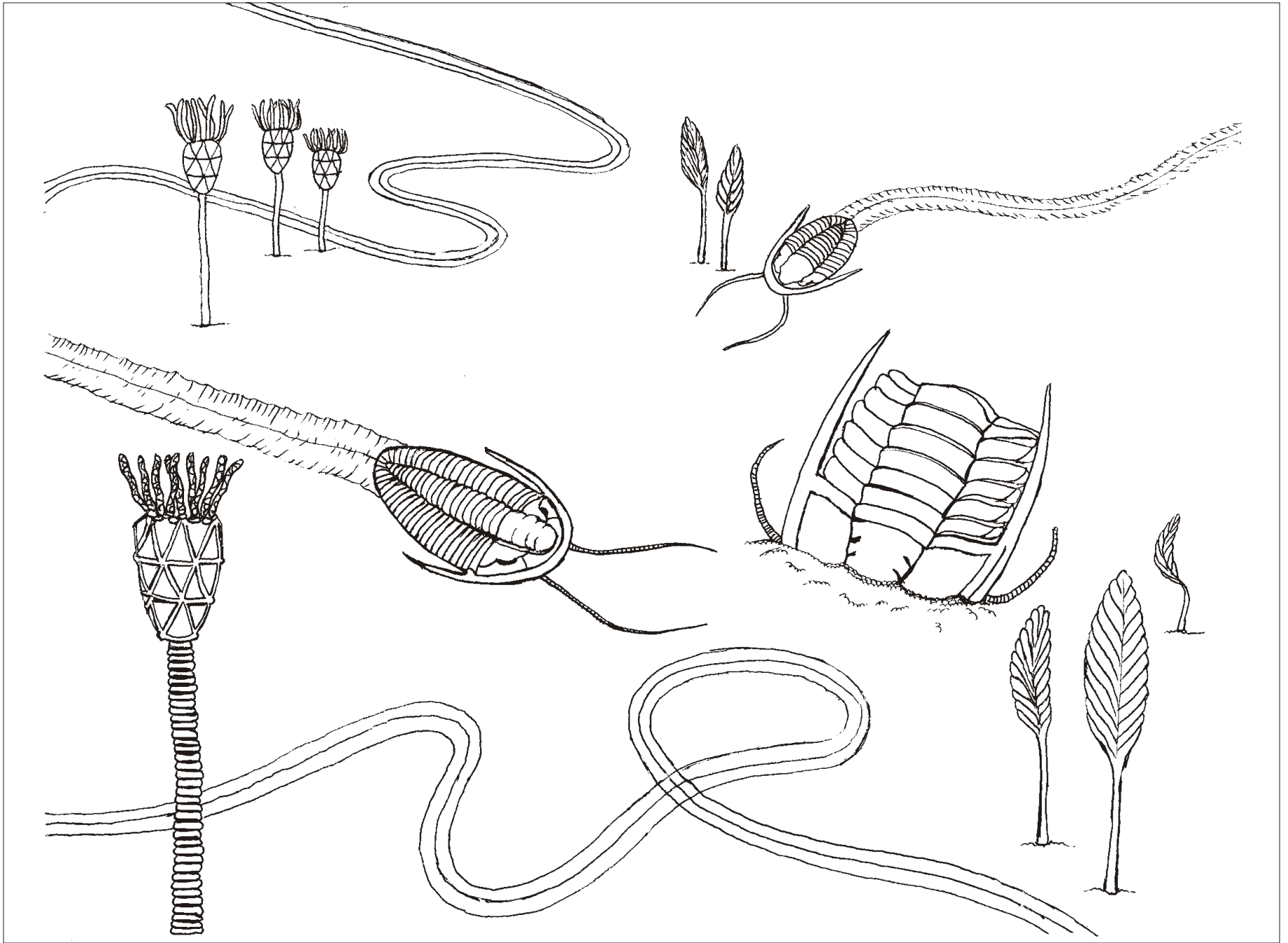

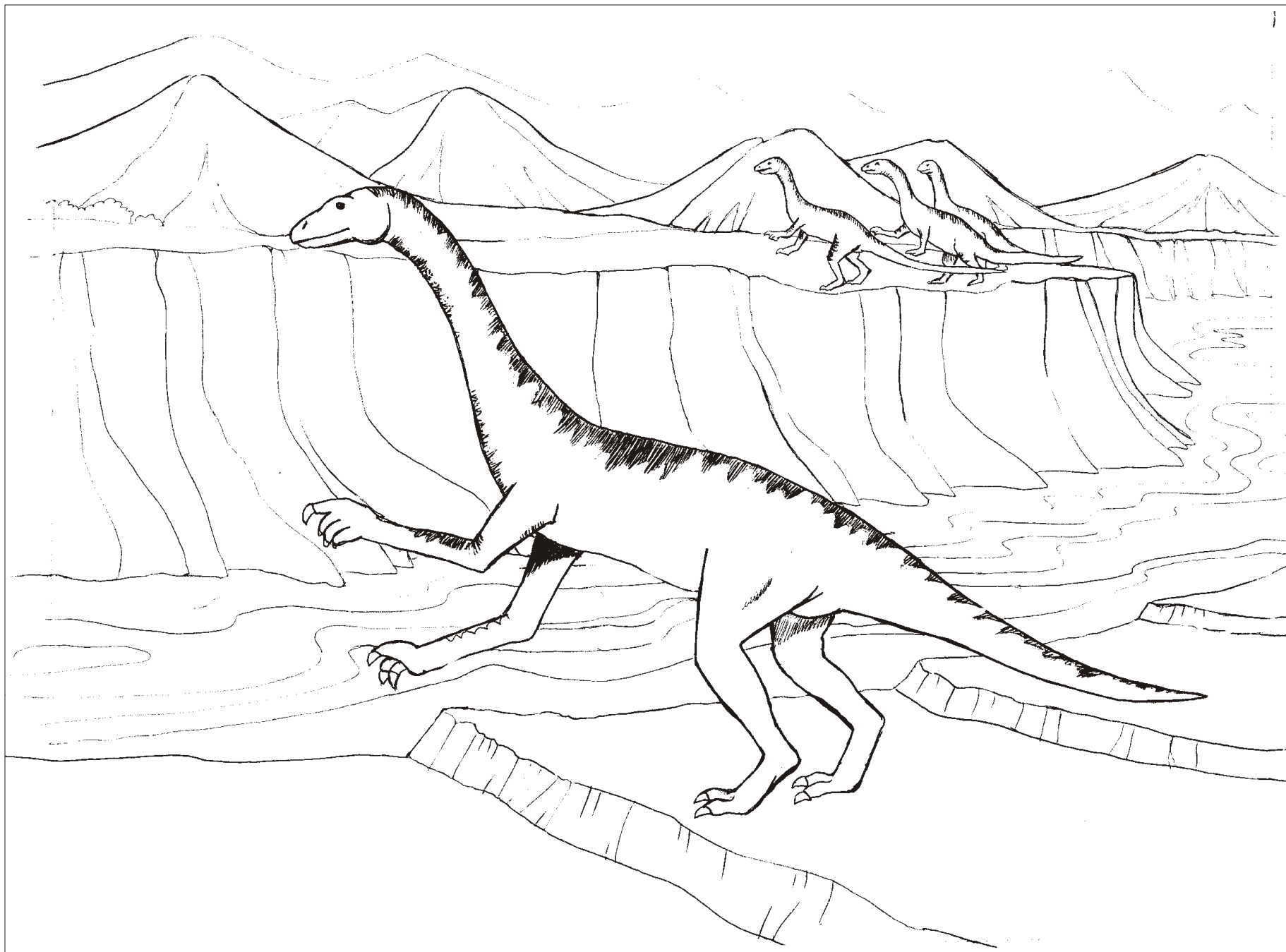
Cambrian sea floor in the Saint John area



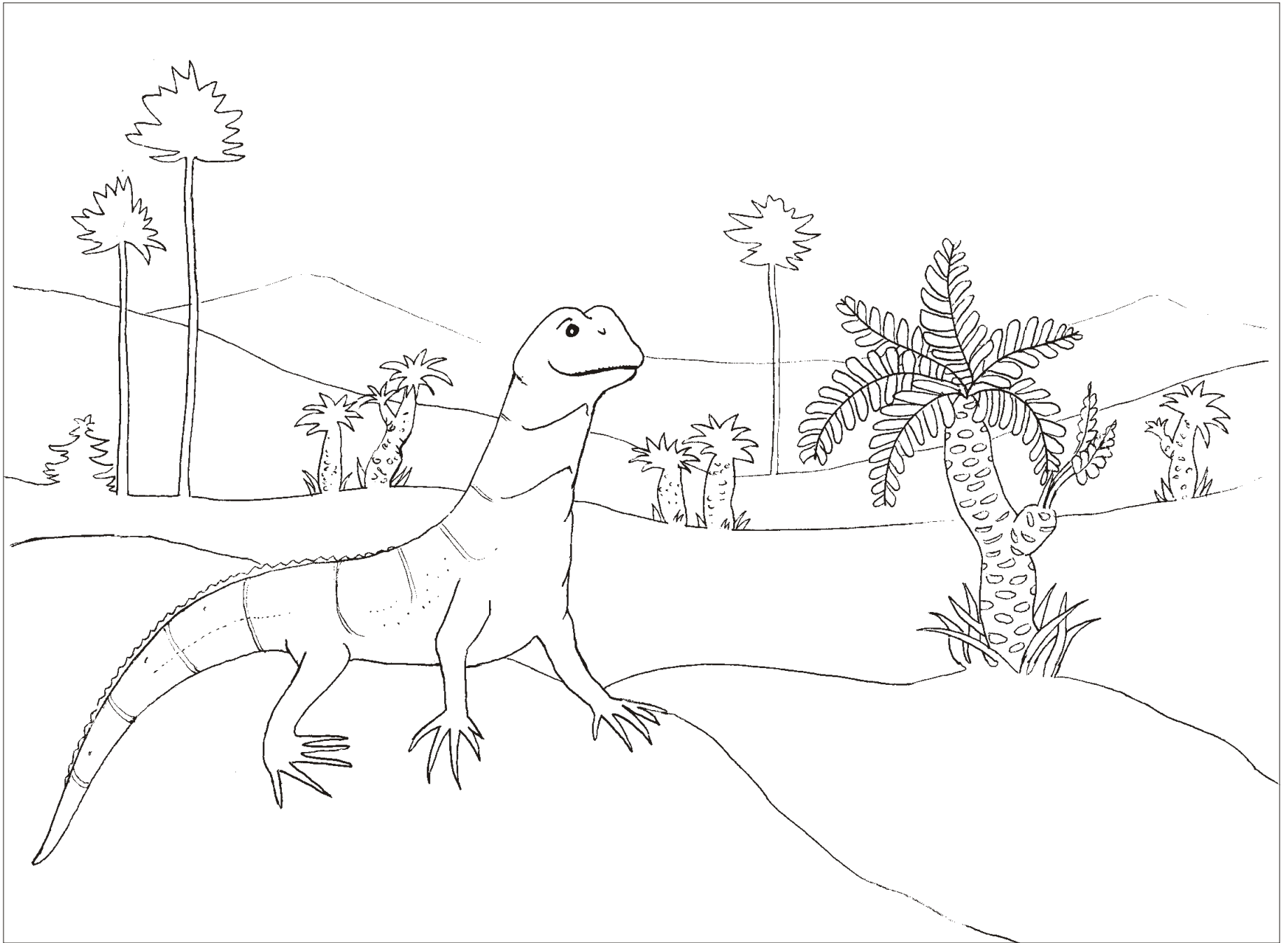
The age of fishes, northern New Brunswick



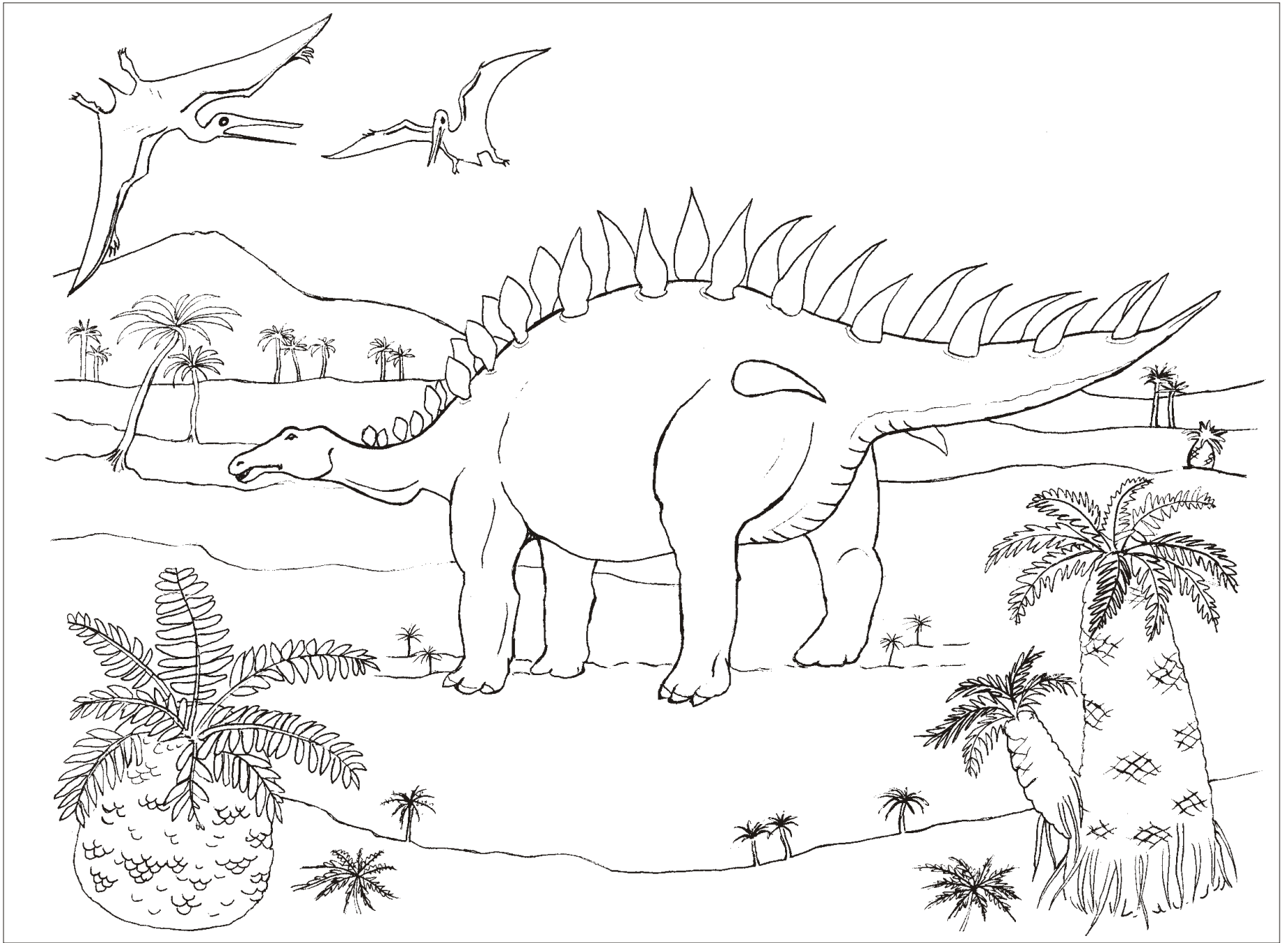
Dimetrodon roams ancient Prince Edward Island

Clevosaurus a Jurassic relative of today's tuatara, basking in the sunshine of the Parrsboro area



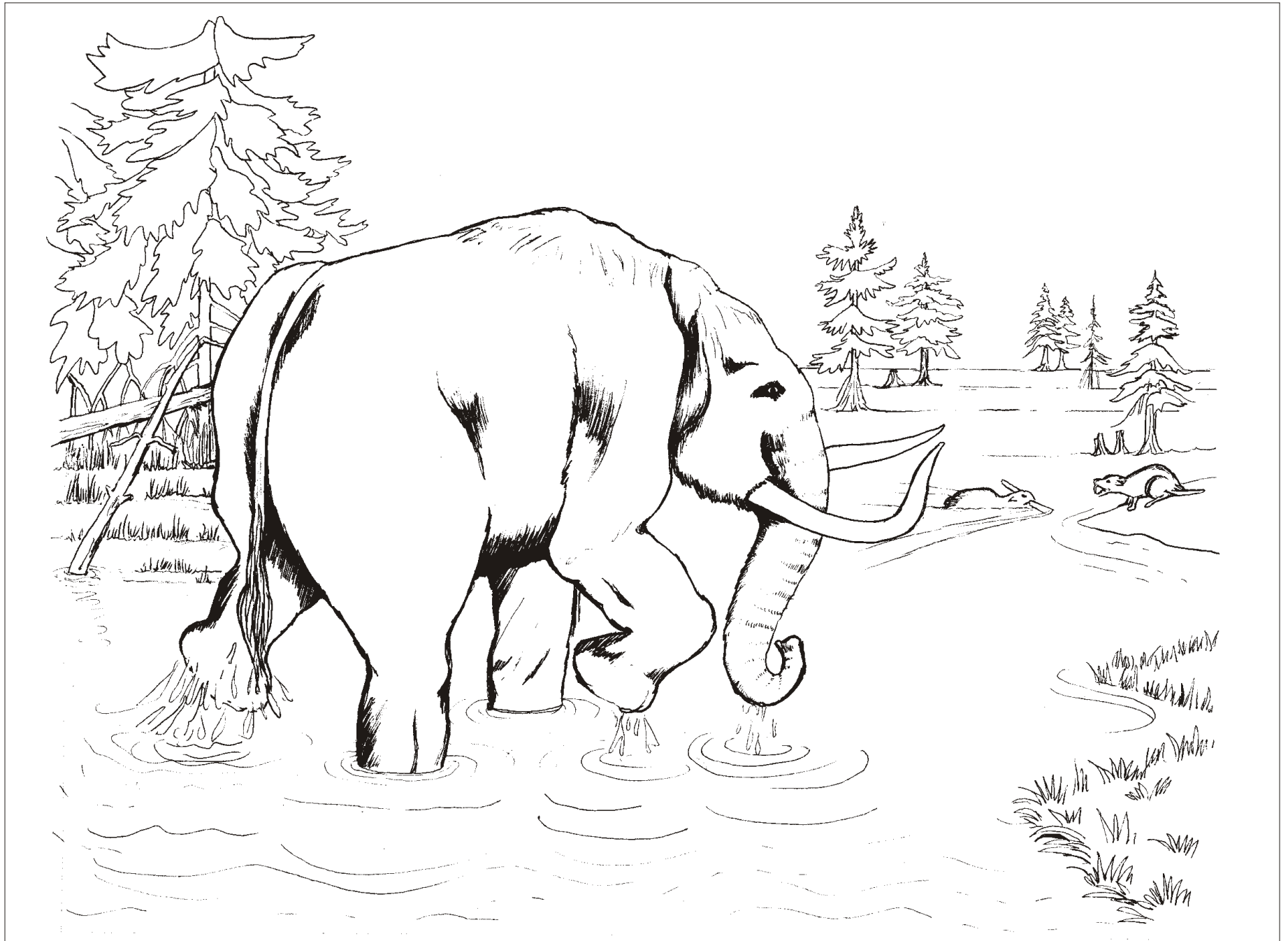
A stegosaur contemplating its next leafy meal, while pterosaurs soar above
