There are two types of organizations that operate with the GH HOA. The first are committees. Committees are formed under the leadership of the HOA Board. They usually serve the purpose to assist with operation of the HOA or to provide organized activities.

A list of the current Committees is:

- Architectural Control Committee (ACC)
- Clubhouse Rental Committee
- Events Committee
- Facilities Committee
- Landscaping Committee
- Welcome Committee

A Club (activity) is the other type of organization within our HOA. A club is formed by a group of residents coming together to share a common interest or activity. These groups are more self-governed, primarily self-sufficient, and self-funded. Clubs must be open to participation by any homeowner in Grand Haven at Alcovy Mountain. Clubs must notify the HOA Secretary of any plans to use the facilities for scheduling purposes. The HOA does not sanction any of the clubs. If a club is either doing something that is not in the best interest of our community or is operating in a manner that the HOA Board deems inappropriate, the HOA Board does have the right and responsibility to terminate that club. Some clubs may choose to raise funds to support the Fun Fund.
