## **Healthy Spinach and Mushroom Omelette**

#### Ingredients

- 2 eggs, yolks and whites separated
- 1 tbs reduced-fat milk
- · olive or canola oil spray
- 4 button mushrooms, sliced
- 1/2 cup baby spinach leaves
- 1 tbs reduced-fat cheddar cheese, grated
- 1 tbs chives, chopped
- · pepper, to taste

#### Method

- 1. Place the egg yolks in a medium bowl. Add the milk and mix well.
- 2. In a separate bowl, whisk the egg whites until soft meringue-like peaks are formed. Gently fold egg whites into the egg yolk mixture and set aside.
- 3. Spray a small non-stick frying pan with oil and place over medium heat. Add mushrooms and cook on medium heat for 3 minutes until softened. Add baby spinach and cook for a further minute until wilted. Remove from pan and wipe pan clean.
- 4. Spray pan again and return to medium heat. Pour in the egg mixture and cook for 2-3 minutes or until surface is nearly firm. Sprinkle the cheese, mushrooms, spinach and pepper over half the omelette, then fold over the other side to enclose the filling. Garnish with the chopped chives.

The new S@H programme is now underway. Our team is actively engaging with Trilogy Cares webinars, to ensure we stay well-informed and prepared for the changes ahead.

We understand that change can raise questions, and we are here to guide you through this transition with clarity and care. This will give you the opportunity to ask questions or seek assistance with the required documentation. If you need more assistance, we would ask that you please make an appointment to come and see us. We have almost 100 clients all wanting our time and we can only manage that with a bit of scheduling!

We had a fantastic turnout of over 80 people to our recent 'Lets Ask Trilogy' session. Apart from the odd little hiccup of information being not quite on the mark - it was a useful and informative session and lots of good questions asked.

We also had a session for our workforce at the Dalby Leagues Club. The invoicing is going to be quite different, but this is to meet the criteria which the government has set for this. As in so many of the moving parts in this transition, it feels clunky and cumbersome, but we live in hope that things will settle into some sort of order after 1 November.
