Policies Changes:

Kingdom Mentoring Network reserve the right to make changes to the Terms of Use, Privacy Policy, and other terms, policies and information at any time and without notice. Any changes made to the Terms of Use or Privacy Policy shall become effective immediately upon posting to our Websites. We may also need to share your Personal Information with other parts of our organization to service your requests or provide you with information or other ministry opportunities.

Lastly, we may use your Personal Information to comply with legal requirements pertaining to your Personal Information or activities, or to enforce our rights as agreed upon under the Terms

of Use. In all these efforts we will take steps to safeguard your Personal Information. By submitting Personal Information to our Website, you understand, agree, and freely consent to allow us to use, store, publish, transmit and process your Personal Information at our discretion in order to provide you with the goods and services you request and to operate our website and services.

Special Rules for Children:

We do not intentionally or knowingly allow Personal Information (name, address, telephone number, or email address) to be collected from anyone under the age of 18. If you believe that we might have any Personal Information from or about anyone under the age of 18, please contact us immediately. In the event we learn that we collected Personal Information from anyone under the age of 18, we will delete that Personal Information as quickly as possible.

Third Party Websites and Information:

Our Websites may contain links to other websites that are run by third parties - such as other organizations, sponsors, content providers, and advertisers. This means that your activity on such sites is subject to the privacy policies and terms of use of the third parties. We are not responsible for the privacy practices or the content of such third-party websites.

Cookies and Technology:

Our Websites may use cookies to keep track of website activities, save your password or deliver content specific to your interests. A cookie is a small data file that certain websites write to your hard drive when you visit them. A cookie file can contain information such as a user ID that the site uses to track the pages you've visited. You can refuse cookies by turning them off in your browser. Most Web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. If you choose to decline cookies, you may not be able to fully experience certain interactive features of our Websites or access all of the services

Our Websites may collect some information (such as your IP address) that may not be readily apparent to you that it is being collected. Security:
