General Policies

- Please note that when visiting or staying in your home, I require that the indoor temperature not exceed 73° F due to a health condition that makes it difficult for me to regulate my body temperature.
- My regular Service Area includes North Orange County (north of and bordering the 22 & 5, west of the 261/241). For clients in surrounding areas, I charge a \$25 fee per visit or stay to cover additional gas and drive time.
- > Holiday Rates apply on the day before, of, and after a federal holiday as well as the contiguous Fri., Sat., Sun., & Mon.

Hourly Services

Hourly services are priced per 30 minutes and not per pet. The service timer starts when I arrive at your door (or property gate if you live in a large complex and are unable to provide an entry code or fob) and stops when I lock the front door to leave.

<u>Drop-In Care Visits</u> include feeding, refilling water, administering noninvasive medications, cleaning-up any minor accidents, and letting pets out to potty &/or cleaning litter. I can sometimes squeeze in a quick 5-10 minute walk as well. I will notify you if there are any major cleaning issues that I won't be able to address during the scheduled visit so you can choose to either extend the visit or do your own cleanup when you get home. Any left over time will be spent cuddling & playing with your pets.

<u>Walks</u> are only scheduled with existing clients, as an occasional courtesy. A 30-minute walk ends up being about 20-25 minutes of actual walking time as it takes a bit to get everyone settled. I book a max of 2 large (>20lbs.), 1 large and 2 small, or 4 small dogs per 30 minute session. If I need to split your pets into 2 groups each will get 10-15 minutes walking time per 30 minutes booked. I don't book 60 minute or midday walks from May through October due to heat. Pricing is the same as for Care Visits.

Daily Services

Daily services are billed per pet. Your highest need pet is billed at the relevant Base Rate; all other pets are billed at one of the Additional Rates. A "night" of sitting covers a 24 hour period starting at my agreed upon arrival time. If my scheduled departure time is 2-8 hours later than the initial arrival time, you will be billed for Extended Care at 50% of your total daily rate. If it is more than 8 hours later, you will be booked for an additional night of services. I book your 3rd pet for free when no more than 1 of your 3 (or more) pets have special needs and/or meet either the Puppy or Continuous Care criteria.

Overnight Pet Sitting Includes administration of food, water and noninvasive medications twice a day, daily litter cleaning &/or 3 potty breaks, clean-up of any accidents, and a maximum of 40 minutes total daily walking time per pet (replaced with indoor enrichment activities when required by my health condition). Lots of playtime and cuddles also included! I'll spend most of my time at your home throughout the day but may leave for up to 8 hours total a day unless you are paying the Continuous Care rate, in which case I will only leave once every 3-4 days for up to 3 hours. Small Pets (rabbits, hamsters etc.) are booked by the cage or enclosure at the cat rate. The Puppy rate is for pets of any age/type who need potty breaks more frequently than once every 6 hours during the day and/or 12 hours (max) overnight. It also applies to pets with extensive behavior issues.

<u>Daytime Pet Sitting</u> For clients who prefer I not spend the night at their home, I may be able to do 2-3 drop-in visits per day between the hours of 9 am and 10 pm for the same rate as overnight housesitting depending on your proximity to my home and/or any other clients I have booked for that day.
