NEW! Sixty Days of Tulips Mix (20)

Tulipa

This mix of early, mid, and late spring bloomers offers your garden fresh bursts of color throughout the season. Each package includes multiple varieties and colors.

Hardiness Zones: 3–8

Plant Type: Perennial Bloom Time: Early to late spring Advantages: Color variety; great in borders or planted in clusters; consider grouping with other flowers such as daffodils or crocuses Mature Plant Size: Varies from 6"–24" tall Light Requirements: Full sun to half sun Plant Depth: 6" deep, 3"–4" apart Soil Type: Loamy, acidic, well-drained soil



NEW! Double Daffodil Duo (8)

Narcissus

These showy blooms are a springtime favorite of gardeners all over! Each package includes a mix of white with pink centers and white with yellow centers.

Hardiness Zones: 3–9 Plant Type: Perennial Bloom Time: Mid to late spring Advantages: Deer and rabbit resistant; can also be planted in containers; beautiful in cut arrangements Mature Plant Size: 12"-24" tall Light Requirements: Full sun to half sun Plant Depth: 7" deep, 3" apart Soil Type: Well-drained, loamy soil



NEW! Purple Sensation Allium (5)

Allium aflatunense or Allium hollandicum

Spectacular globe-shaped purple flowers 3"–5" across bloom in late spring to early summer. This deer-resistant gem is an excellent choice for cut arrangements, attracts butterflies, and will naturalize over time.

Hardiness Zones: 4–9 Plant Type: Perennial Bloom Time: Late spring to early summer Advantages: Deer, rabbit, and drought resistant Mature Plant Size: 24"–36" tall Light Requirements: Full sun Plant Depth: 6"–8" deep, 8" apart Soil Type: Neutral, well-drained soil



FAN FAVORITE! Tulip Mix (20)

Tulipa

Enjoy blooms from mid to late spring in a variety of colors including yellow, pink, orange, and red.

Hardiness Zones: 3–8 Plant Type: Perennial Bloom Time: Mid to late spring Advantages: Color variety; use in cut arrangements Mature Plant Size: Varies from 6"–24" tall Light Requirements: Full sun to half sun Plant Depth: 6" deep, 3"–4" apart Soil Type: Loamy, acidic, well-drained soil



Snow Crocus Mix (25)

Crocus chrysanthus

These petite favorites are among the first to emerge in springtime and feature a palette of purples and yellows.

Hardiness Zones: 3–9 Plant Type: Perennial Bloom Time: Early spring Advantages: Perfect choice for borders and small spaces Mature Plant Size: 4" tall Light Requirements: Full sun to half sun Plant Depth: 3" deep, 1"–2" apart Soil Type: Loamy, acidic, well-drained soil



FAN FAVORITE! Daffodil Bulb Mix (25)

Narcissus

A springtime favorite, this assortment can include colors from white to yellow-orange and sizes from small cup to trumpet.

Hardiness Zones: 3–8 Plant Type: Perennial Bloom Time: Early to late spring Advantages: Deer, drought, and rabbit resistant Mature Plant Size: Varies up to 20" tall Light Requirements: Full sun to half sun Plant Depth: 6" deep, 3"–4" apart Soil Type: Well-drained, loamy soil




FAN FAVORITE! Snake's Head (10)

Fritillaria meleagris

Eye-catching checkered purple blooms are the focal point of this deer-resistant wonder. Good container plant.

Hardiness Zones: 4–8

Plant Type: Perennial Bloom Time: Mid spring Advantages: Deer and rabbit resistant Mature Plant Size: 10" tall Light Requirements: Full sun to part sun Plant Depth: 6" deep, 3"–4" apart Soil Type: Loamy, average soil



Glory of the Snow (25)

Chionodoxa luciliae

As the name implies, this one is an early bloomer! Growing low to the ground, it naturalizes easily and is an excellent choice for borders and rock gardens.

Hardiness Zones: 3–8 Plant Type: Perennial Bloom Time: Early spring Advantages: Deer and rabbit resistant Mature Plant Size: Approx. 3"–6" tall Light Requirements: Full sun to partial sun Plant Depth: 4" deep, 2"–4" apart Soil Type: Average, well-drained soil



FAN FAVORITE! Pink Lily Leek (40)

Allium oreophilum

Also known as Alpine Rosy Bells, this deer-resistant plant bears clusters of rosy pink flowers in late spring to early summer.

Hardiness Zones: 4–9

Plant Type: Perennial Bloom Time: Late spring to early summer Advantages: Deer and rabbit resistant; attracts butterflies Mature Plant Size: Approx. 8"–12" tall Light Requirements: Full sun Plant Depth: 2"–3" deep, 3" apart Soil Type: Loamy, well-drained soil



FAN FAVORITE! Grecian Windflower Mix (15)

Anemone blanda

This beauty features daisy-like flowers, is deer resistant, and is an excellent choice for rock gardens as well as containers.

Hardiness Zones: 5–9 Plant Type: Perennial Bloom Time: Early to mid spring Advantages: Deer and rodent resistant Mature Plant Size: Approx. 4"–6" tall Light Requirements: Half sun/half shade Plant Depth: 3"–4" deep, 2"–4" apart Soil Type: Rich, Ioamy, well-drained soil

We source our bulbs directly from Holland. These healthy, hardy, and unique varieties will succeed in various areas throughout the contiguous United States. The larger bulb sizes we offer will maximize the blooms in your garden right from the start.

With your bulbs, you will receive a general instruction sheet for planting. Bulbs should be planted as soon as the ground is cool, when evening temperatures average between $40^{\circ}-50^{\circ}$ F. You should plant at least six weeks before the ground freezes.

Know your hardiness zone, and be aware of the recommended hardiness zones for any bulbs you purchase. You can find out your hardiness zone by checking the map on the USDA's website at plants.usda.gov/hardiness.html. A hardiness zone map is also available on the landing page for the fundraiser you are supporting.
