Karl Rosenfield Peony (1)

Paeonia Lactiflora

This gardener's favorite bears double cherry-red flowers in late spring to early summer. Though peonies will not bloom the first year and may take up to two years to fully mature, the showy and fragrant blooms are well worth the wait!

Hardiness Zones: 3–8

Plant Type: Perennial

Bloom Time: Late spring to early summer

Advantages: Deer resistant; bee and butterfly attractor; great for cut arrangements

Mature Plant Size: Approx. 24"–36" tall

Light Requirements: Full sun to part sun

Plant Depth: 1" deep, 24"–30" apart

Soil Type: Loamy soil

Raspberry Sundae Peony (1)

Paeonia Lactiflora

Deer-resistant peonies are prized for their large, fragrant flowers that attract pollinators and are perfect for cut arrangements.

Once established, you'll enjoy beautiful blooms in shades of pink and creamy pale yellow in the raspberry sundae peony.

Hardiness Zones: 3–8

Plant Type: Perennial

Bloom Time: Late spring to early summer

Advantages: Deer resistant; bee and butterfly attractor; great for cut arrangements

Mature Plant Size: Approx. 24"–36" tall

Light Requirements: Full sun to part sun

Plant Depth: 1" deep, 24"–30" apart

NEW! Yellow Mignon Dahlia (3)

Dahlia

This single dahlia is hardy in warmer zones, but can be grown as an annual in zones 3 to 7. Bright yellow flowers bloom in mid to late summer, and sometimes even into early fall.

Hardiness Zones: 8–10

Plant Type: Perennial in zones 8–10; annual in zones 3–7

Bloom Time: Mid to late summer

Advantages: Attracts pollinators; great for container gardens; use in cut arrangements

Mature Plant Size: 12"–18" tall

Light Requirements: Full sun

Plant Depth: 1"–2" deep, 12"–15" apart

Soil Type: Moist, well-drained soil

Rainbow Gladiolus Mix (40)

Gladiolus

Enjoy a summer cutting garden full of showy blooms! Plant a large number of bulbs grouped together for a dramatic effect. In zones 3–7, dig up bulbs to store indoors for winter.

Hardiness Zones: 8–11

Plant Type: Perennial in zones 8–11; dig up and store over winter in zones 3–7

Bloom Time: Midsummer


Advantages: Cut arrangements; butterfly and hummingbird attractor

Mature Plant Size: Approx. 48"–60" tall

Light Requirements: Full sun

Plant Depth: 4"–6" deep, 5" apart

Pompon Dahlia (3)

Dahlia

These colorful flowers bloom for months, attracting butterflies and providing beautiful blossoms for cut arrangements. Perfect for container gardens as well!

Hardiness Zones: 8–10

Plant Type: Perennial in zones 8–10; dig up and store over winter in zones 3–7

Bloom Time: Mid to late summer

Advantages: Attracts butterflies; great for cut arrangements; excellent choice for container gardening

Mature Plant Size: Approx. 24"–36" tall

Light Requirements: Full sun

Plant Depth: 2" deep, 12"–15" apart

Soil Type: Moist but well-drained soil

Columbine (5)

Aquilegia

This hardy, shade-loving flower has unique, star-shaped petals that bloom in late spring. It's a favorite of hummingbirds and butterflies. For best results in cut flower arrangements, pick when the blooms are only half-open.

Hardiness Zones: 3–9

Plant Type: Perennial

Bloom Time: Late spring to early summer

Advantages: Deer resistant; attracts pollinators; good for small spaces

Mature Plant Size: Approx. 24"–28" tall

Light Requirements: Part sun to full shade

Plant Depth: 2" deep, 12"–24" apart

Soil Type: Moist but well-drained soil

False Spirea Mix (3)

Astilbe

The unique, spiky plumes of astilbe will provide a variety of color in your midsummer garden. Also known as false spirea, it's deer resistant and so easy to grow!

Hardiness Zones: 3–8

Plant Type: Perennial

Bloom Time: Mid to late summer

Advantages: Easy to grow; deer resistant; attracts butterflies

Mature Plant Size: Approx. 20"–36" tall

Light Requirements: Half sun/half shade to full shade

Plant Depth: 1" deep, 12" apart

Soil Type: Moist, rich, well-drained soil

Hardy Gladiolus Mix (20)

Gladiolus Nanus

Cold-hardy to zone 5, this smaller growing gladiolus is an excellent choice for a perennial border or cutting garden. Plus, hummingbirds love it and the deer will stay away from it!

Hardiness Zones: 5–8

Plant Type: Perennial

Bloom Time: Mid to late summer


Advantages: Easy to grow; deer resistant; use in cut arrangements

Globe Thistle (5)

Echinops Ritro

A sun-loving, reblooming perennial, globe thistle is an excellent choice for your cutting garden. This low-maintenance plant bears golf-ball-sized blooms in mid to late summer and will attract bees and butterflies to your garden.

Hardiness Zones: 3–8

Plant Type: Perennial

Bloom Time: Mid to late summer


Advantages: Deer resistant; attracts pollinators; use in cut arrangements

Butterfly Weed (5)

Asclepias Tuberosa

This member of the milkweed family has a lot going for it. Its beautiful blooms attract butterflies and hummingbirds, it's resistant to deer and rabbits, and the flowers and seed pods are stunning in cut arrangements. It can take up to 3 years to fully mature.

Hardiness Zones: 3–9

Plant Type: Perennial

Bloom Time: Early through late summer


Advantages: Deer and rabbit resistant; attracts pollinators; low maintenance

Mature Plant Size: Approx. 18"–30" tall

Light Requirements: Full sun

Plant Depth: 1" deep, 18"–24" apart

Soil Type: Dry to moderately moist, well-drained soil



Lavender Perfection Dahlia (3)

Dahlia

This classic heirloom variety with 8"–10" blooms makes a beautiful addition to any garden. It's also an excellent choice for cut flower arrangements. In zones 3–7, dig up bulbs to store indoors for winter.

Hardiness Zones: 8–10

Plant Type: Perennial in zones 8–10; annual in zones 3–7

Bloom Time: Summer through fall


Advantages: Cut arrangements; butterfly and hummingbird attractor

Mature Plant Size: Approx. 36"–48" tall

Light Requirements: Full sun

Plant Depth: 1"–2" deep, 18"–24" apart

Soil Type: Sandy or loamy soil



Freesia Mix (20)

Freesia

Long-lasting and fragrant, Freesia come in an endless rainbow of colors and make the perfect cut flower. Grow outdoors in an established bed, or force bulbs through winter indoors.

Hardiness Zones: 4–10

Plant Type: Annual in most zones; perennial in zones 9–10

Bloom Time: Late spring to midsummer


Advantages: Easy to grow; great for containers and cut flowers

Mature Plant Size: Approx. 18"–24" tall

Light Requirements: Full sun

Plant Depth: 3" deep, 2"–3" apart

Soil Type: Sandy or loamy soil



Stella D'Oro Daylily (3)

Hemerocallis

Gardeners love this perennial for its stunning flowers and ease of care. Remove the spent blooms and seed pods after flowering to encourage reblooming.

Hardiness Zones: 3–9

Plant Type: Perennial

Bloom Time: Early to midsummer and late summer

Advantages: Reblooming; rabbit resistant; drought tolerant; butterfly attractor

Mature Plant Size: Approx. 12" tall

Light Requirements: Full sun to half sun/half shade

Plant Depth: 1" deep, 12"–18" apart

Soil Type: Well-drained, loamy soil



Unwin's Mix Dahlia (5)

Dahlia

The explosion of color in this semi-dwarf Dahlia mix would make a beautiful border for your garden. It's also an excellent choice for cut flowers. In zones 3–7, dig up bulbs to store indoors for winter.

Hardiness Zones: 8–10

Plant Type: Perennial in zones 8–10; annual in zones 3–7

Bloom Time: Midsummer until frost

Advantages: Excellent choice for borders or container gardens

Mature Plant Size: Approx. 16"–24" tall

Light Requirements: Full sun

Plant Depth: 1"–2" deep, 8"–12" apart

Soil Type: Sandy or loamy soil



Hosta Mix (3)

Hosta

This shade-loving plant offers intriguing foliage and tall stems bearing trumpet-shaped midsummer blossoms in purple or white. Ideal for borders or planted in clusters.

Hardiness Zones: 3–8

Plant Type: Perennial

Bloom Time: Midsummer

Advantages: Easy care; ideal for shady areas; spreads easily

Mature Plant Size: 15"–30" tall

Light Requirements: Half sun/half shade to full shade

Plant Depth: 1"–2" deep, 15"–24" apart

Soil Type: Well-drained, loamy soil



Blazing Star (20)

Liatris spicata

A favorite of Monarch butterflies, the Blazing Star is perfect for a meadow or perennial garden border. Will grow in full sun to partial shade and grows well in average soil.

Hardiness Zones: 3–8

Plant Type: Perennial

Bloom Time: Late Summer


Advantages: Deer resistant; attracts hummingbirds and butterflies

Mature Plant Size: Approx. 24"–48"

Light Requirements: Full sun to half sun/half shade

Plant Depth: 6" deep, 12"–15" apart

Soil Type: Sandy or loamy soil



Caesar's Brother Siberian Iris (3)

Iris Sibirica

Stunning, velvety purple blooms are the highlight of this easy-to-care-for plant. Plant them grouped in a bed or as a border accent.

Hardiness Zones: 3–8

Plant Type: Perennial

Bloom Time: Late spring to early summer

Advantages: Low maintenance; deer and rabbit resistant; tolerant of clay soils

Mature Plant Size: Approx. 36"–48" tall

Light Requirements: Full sun to half sun/half shade

Plant Depth: 1"–2" deep, 18"–24" apart

Soil Type: Moist, well-drained soil

Crocsmia Mix (5)

Crocsmia

Sprays of red, orange, and yellow flowers bloom along graceful stems. Though Crocsmia might not bloom the first year, you'll enjoy plentiful blossoms for many years to come!

Hardiness Zones: 5–9

Plant Type: Perennial

Bloom Time: Mid to late summer


Advantages: Deer and rabbit resistant; attracts butterflies and hummingbirds

Mature Plant Size: Approx. 18"–24" tall

Light Requirements: Full sun to half sun/half shade

Plant Depth: 3"–5" deep, 6"–8" apart

Soil Type: Moist but well-drained soil

Summer Sun Garden Mix (80)

Lilium, Freesia, Gladiolus Nanus, Liatris

Fill up a flowerbed with this collection of sun-loving summer bloomers! Attract pollinators to your garden or create beautiful cut arrangements. Set includes 10 Golden Yellow Lily, 20 Freesia Mix, 20 Hardy Gladiolus Mix, and 30 Blazing Star for a total of 80 bulbs (shown clockwise from upper right).

Hardiness Zones: 5–8

Plant Type: Lily, hardy gladiolus, and blazing star are perennial; freesia are annual in most zones, perennial in zones 9–10

Bloom Time: Late spring to late summer depending on variety

Advantages: Easy to grow; for cut arrangements, deer resistance, or pollinator attraction depending on variety

Mature Plant Sizes: 18"–48" depending on variety

Light Requirements: Full sun

Plant Depth: For lily and blazing star, 6" deep and 12"–15" apart; for freesia, 3" deep and 2"–3" apart; for hardy gladiolus, 6" deep and 2"–3" apart

Soil Type: Average soil; moist and well-drained

NEW! Butterfly Garden Collection (21)

Asclepias Tuberosa, Echinops Ritro, Dahlia, Crocosmia

Attract butterflies and other pollinators to your garden with this assortment of flowers that will provide an explosion of color all summer long. You'll also enjoy a variety of cut flowers to brighten up your home both inside and out. Collection includes 5 Butterfly Weed, 5 Globe Thistle, 3 Yellow Mignon Dahlia, 3 Pompon Dahlia, and 5 Crocosmia Mix.

Hardiness Zones: 3–11 depending on variety; dahlias should be treated as an annual or dug up and stored indoors over winter in zones 3–7

Plant Type: Butterfly weed, globe thistle, and crocosmia are perennial; yellow mignon dahlia and pompon dahlia are perennial in zones 8–10 and annual in zones 3–7

Bloom Time: Early summer to late summer depending on variety

Advantages: Butterfly attractor; great for cut arrangements

Mature Plant Size: 12"–36" depending on variety

Light Requirements: Full sun

Plant Depth: For butterfly weed and globe thistle, 1" deep and 18" apart; for yellow mignon dahlia and pompon dahlia, 2" deep and 12"–15" apart; for crocosmia mix, 3"–5" deep and 6"–8" apart

Soil Type: Moist, well-drained soil

About Our Bulbs

We source our bulbs directly from Holland. These healthy, hardy, and unique varieties will succeed in various areas throughout the contiguous United States. The larger bulb sizes we offer will maximize the blooms in your garden right from the start.

With your bulbs, you will receive an instruction sheet for planting. Bulbs should be planted immediately upon arrival; if the danger of frost has not passed in your area, you can either store your roots in a cool area for two to three days or plant them in pots indoors until the outside weather warms.

Know your hardiness zone, and be aware of the recommended hardiness zones for any bulbs you purchase. You can find out your hardiness zone by checking the map on the USDA's website

at plants.usda.gov/hardiness.html. A hardiness zone map is also available on the landing page for the fundraiser you are supporting.

Bulbs that are not hardy to your area will need to be dug up before the first hard frost and stored in a cool, dark, dry location through winter. Winter storage instructions are also provided on the instruction sheet you will receive with your bulb order.
