Classroom Supply List for First Grade

- I pencil box containing:
 - 3 sharpened pencils
 - 1 pink block eraser (Please do not send cap erasers)
 - 2 large, non-scented glue sticks
 - 1 pair of scissors
- 1 Primary Composition Book (Full sheet with dotted mid-lines/ Mead is a good brand)
- 1 binder pouch with a zipper containing 1 box of 24-count crayons with the crayons removed from the box (Crayola preferred)
- 1 box of 24-count crayons (Crayola preferred /labeled with your child's name for 2nd semester)
- 1 binder pouch with a zipper containing 2 Expo dry erase markers (Name brand please / any size/ any color) and 1 dry erase eraser
- 1 pair of headphones (Please label headphones /place in a labeled gallon zip-lock bag)
- 1 <u>Over-Size</u> Shirt for Art Class (Please <u>label</u> the inside of the art shirt /place in a <u>labeled</u> gallon zip-lock bag) This may be worn over top of your child's regular shirt during art class.

* It will be very helpful if you can **unpackage** all pencils, erasers, dry erase markers, glue sticks, and scissors from the store packaging.
